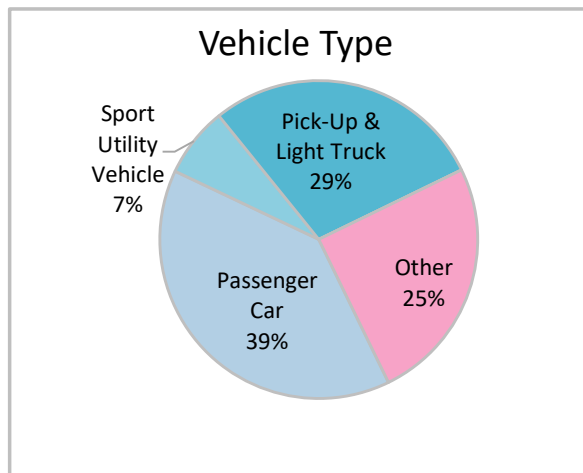
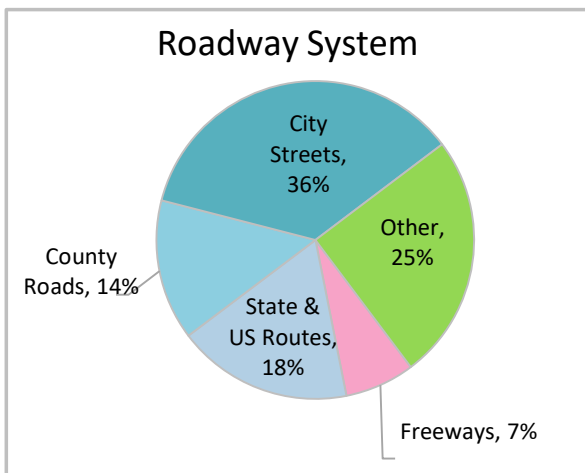
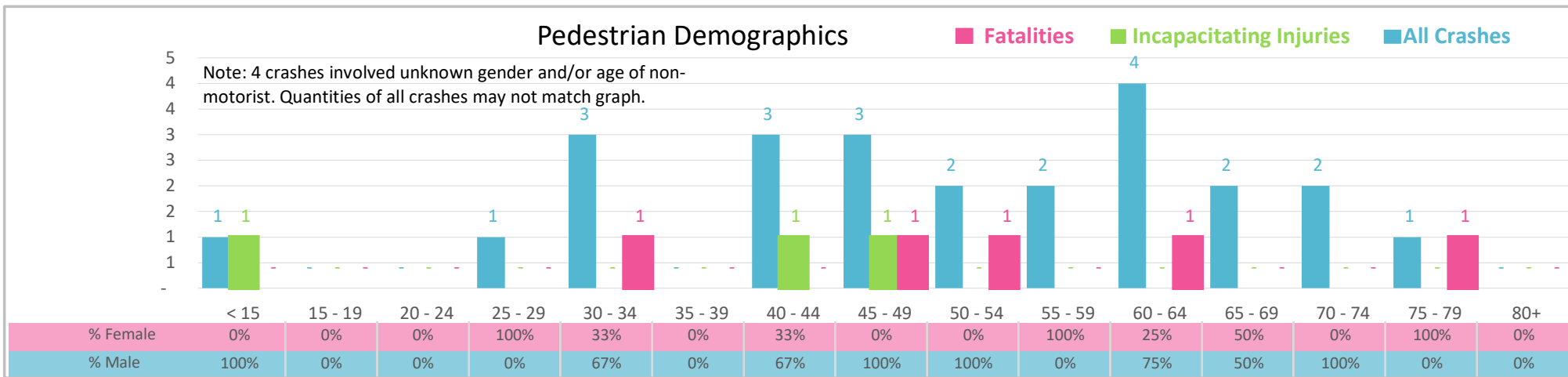

- ### Key Pedestrian Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 70,385.
  - Pedestrian age is distributed broadly across all age groups under 70; male pedestrians account for 63% of all crashes and the 5 fatalities.
  - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 3 crashes and resulted in 1 fatality.
  - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 2 crashes.
  - 36% of crashes occurred along City Streets with most of the remainder occurring on Other Roadway Systems.
  - Passenger car accounted for 39% of the motor vehicles involved in pedestrian crashes
  - 50% of crashes occurred at night resulting in the 5 fatalities.
