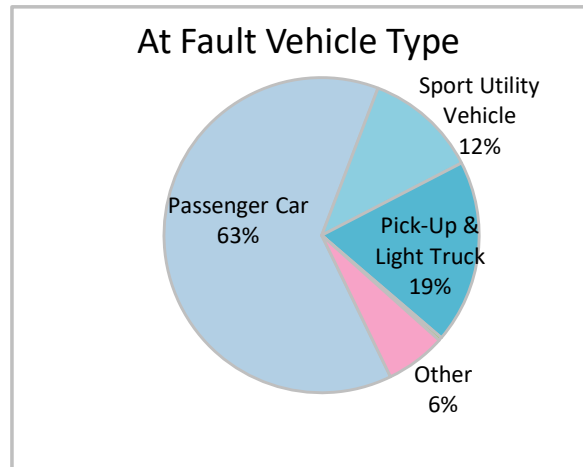
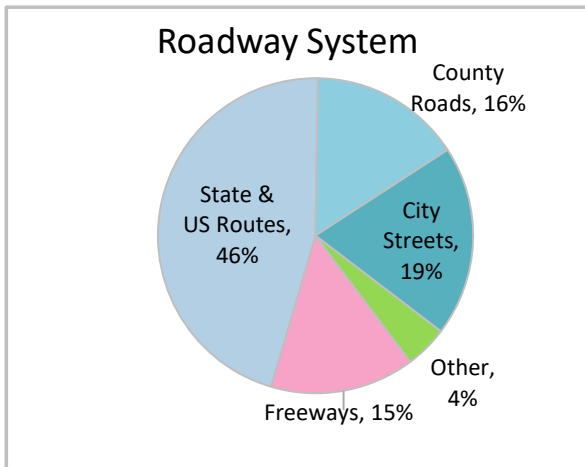
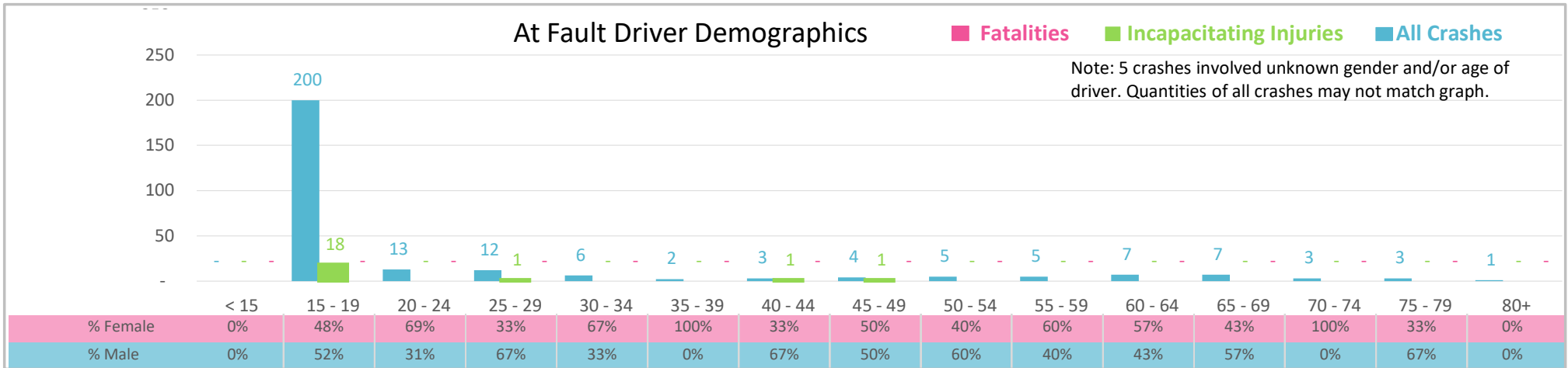

- ### Key Teen Driver Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 70,385.
  - 72% of crashes involved drivers under 20; male drivers account for 51% of all crashes.
  - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 6% of crashes.
  - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 5 crashes.
  - 46% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on City Streets.
  - Passenger car accounted for 63% of motor vehicles involved in teen driver crashes.
  - 29% of crashes occurred at night.
