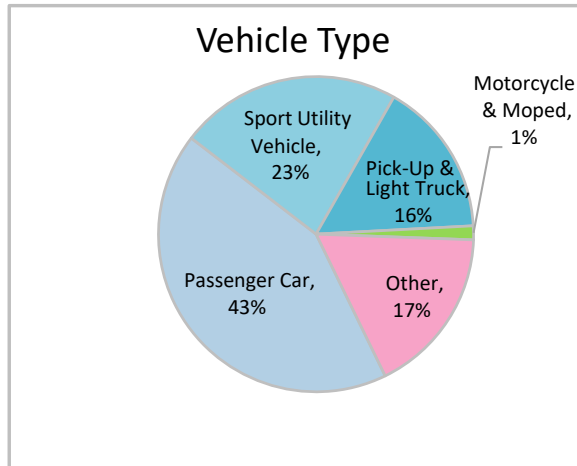
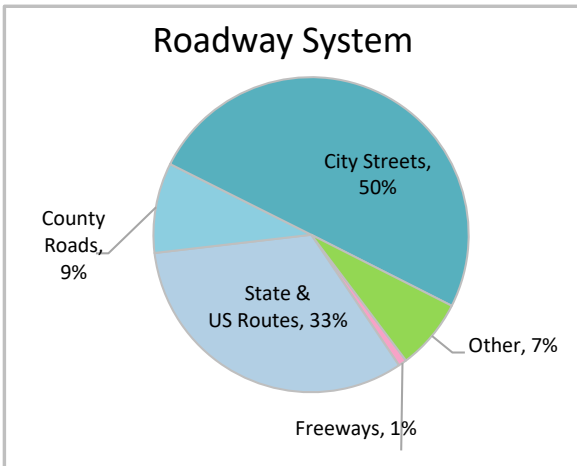
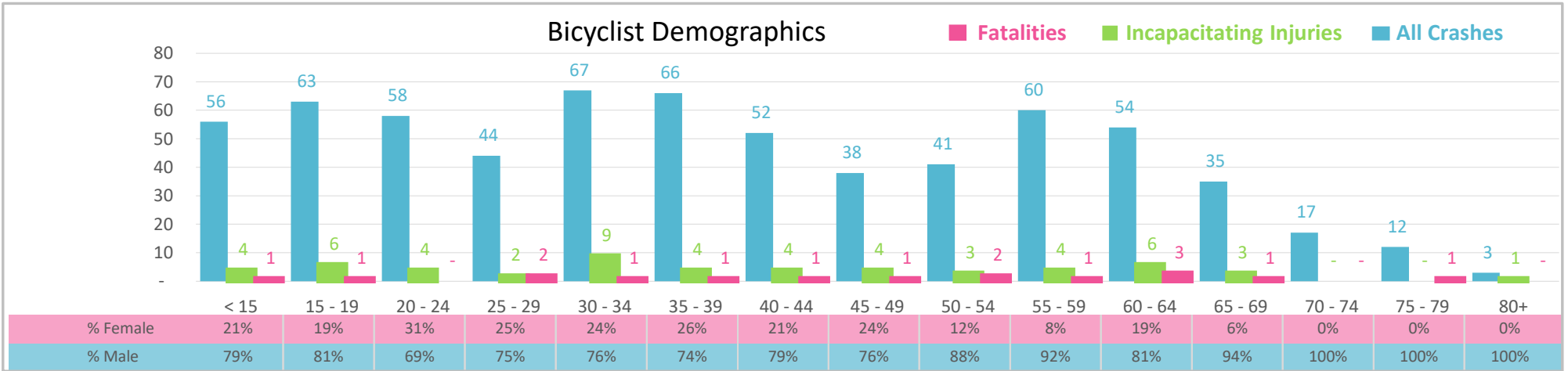

- ### Key Bicycle Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 2,292,914.
 - Cyclist age is distributed broadly across all age groups under 70; male cyclists account for 55% of all crashes and 81% of fatal crashes.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 5 crashes.
 - 50% of crashes occurred along city streets with most of the remainder occurring on state and US routes.
 - Passenger cars accounted for 43% of the motor vehicles involved in bike crashes.
 - Nighttime crashes accounted for 72% of fatalities.
