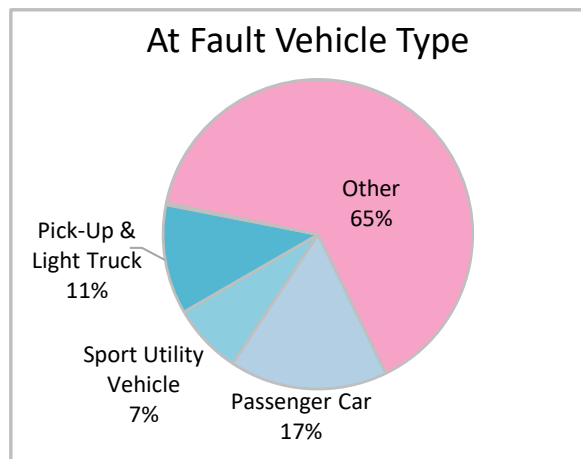
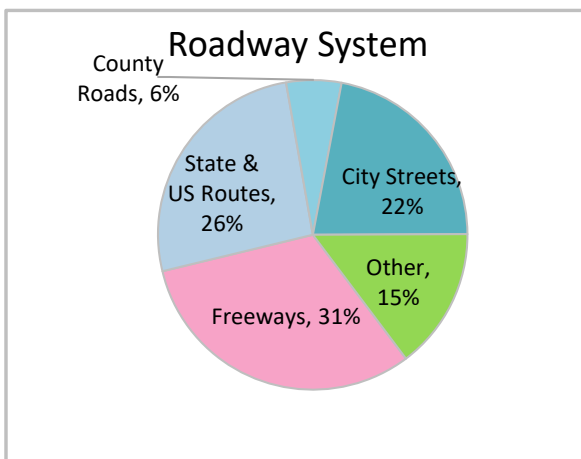
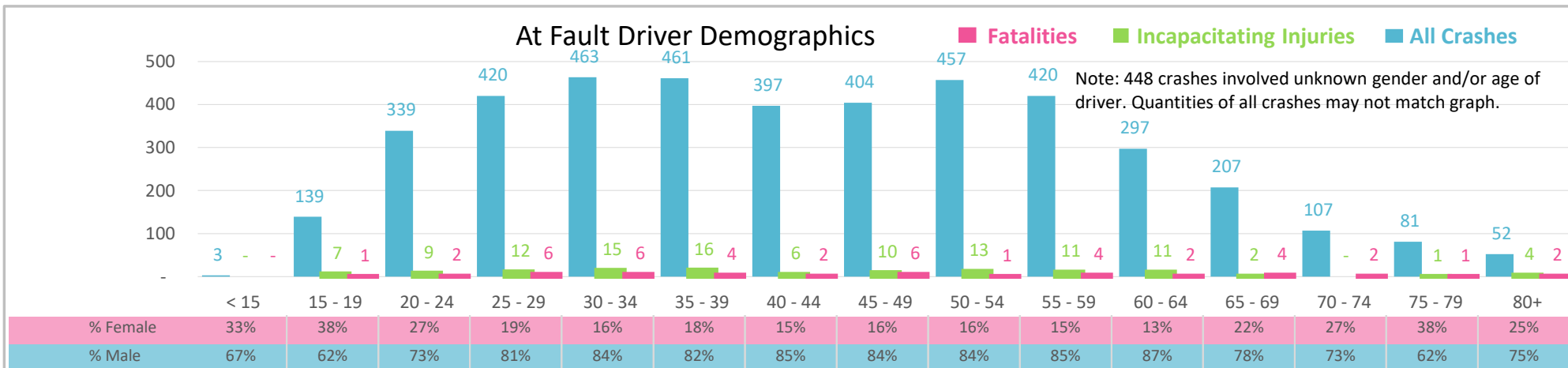

- ### Key Commercial Motor Vehicle Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 2,292,914.
 - Driver age is distributed broadly across all age groups under 65; male drivers account for 81% of all crashes and 73% of fatalities.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 4% of crashes and resulted in 27% of fatalities.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 1% of crashes and resulted in 9 fatalities.
 - 31% of crashes occurred along Freeways with most of the remainder occurring on State and US Routes.
 - Other vehicle type accounted for 65% of motor vehicles involved in commercial vehicle crashes.
 - 22% of crashes occurred at night with 36% of fatalities.
