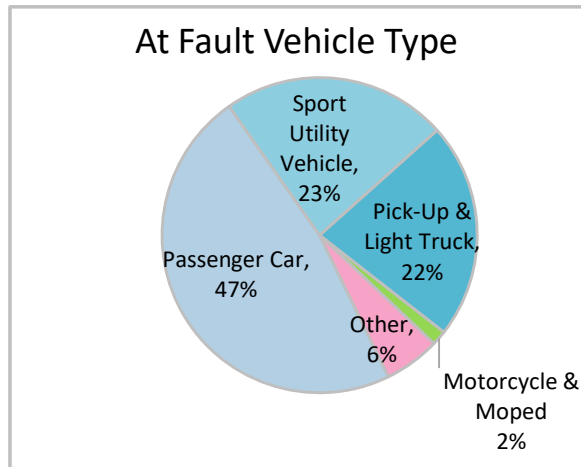
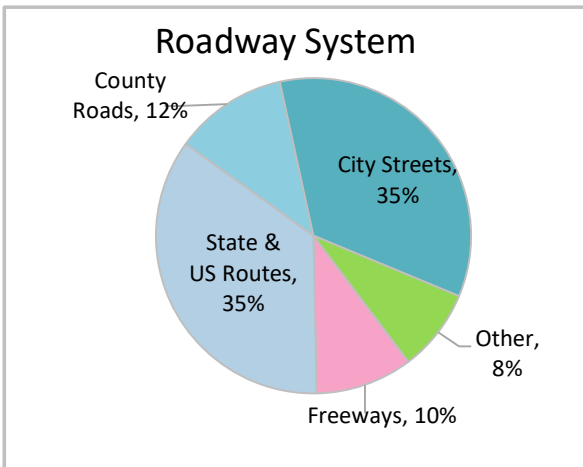
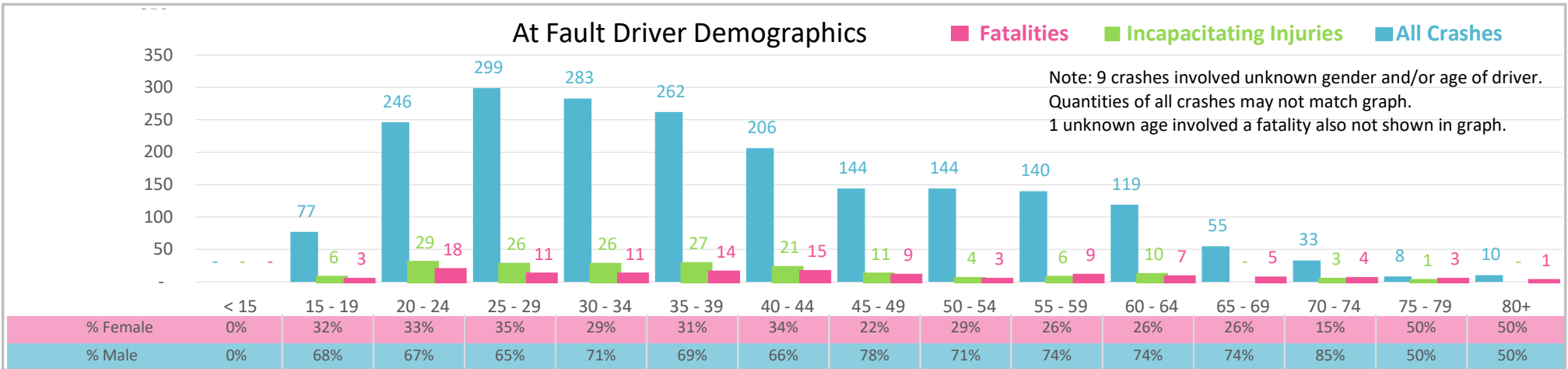

- ### Key Impaired Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 2,292,914.
  - 57% of crashes involved drivers under 40; male drivers account for 70% of all crashes and 85% of fatal crashes.
  - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 14% of crashes and resulted in 54% fatalities.
  - 35% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes and City Streets.
  - Passenger cars accounted for 47% of motor vehicles involved in distracted driving crashes.
  - 68% of crashes occurred at night with 67% impaired fatalities.
