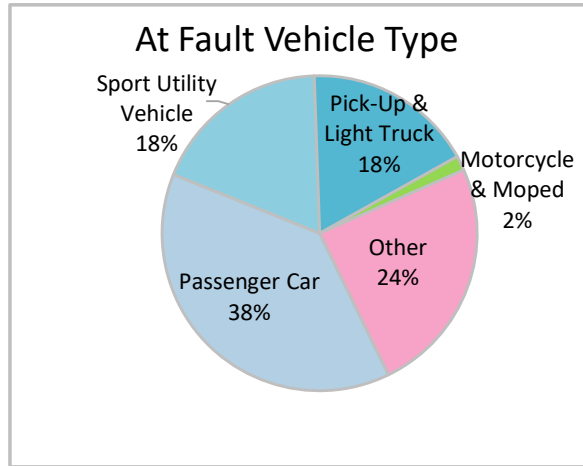
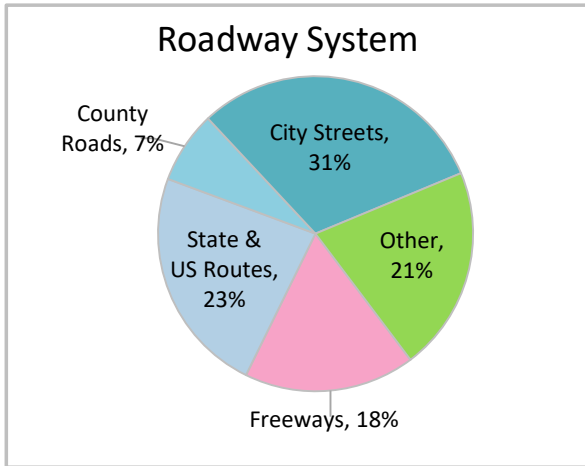
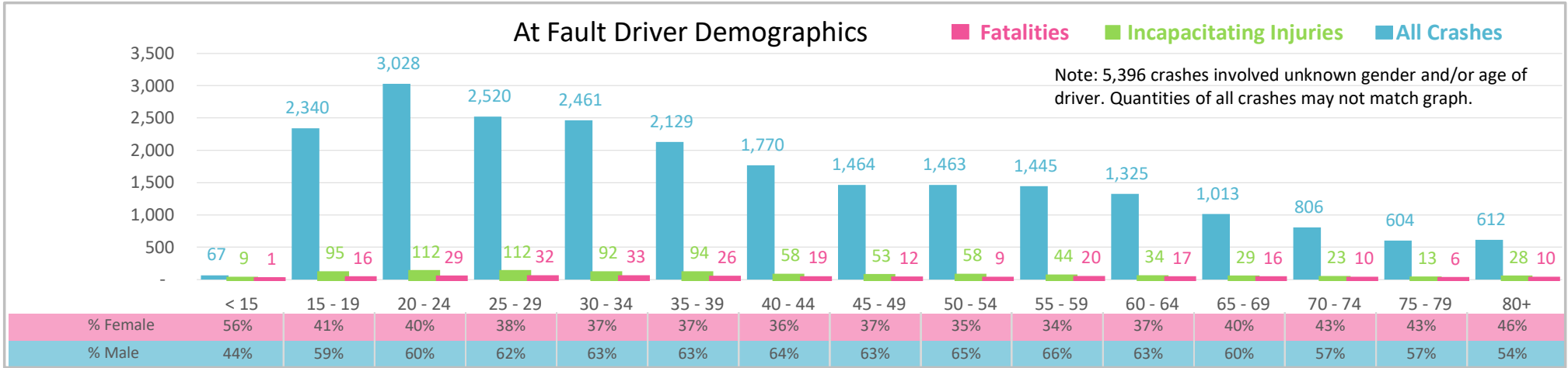

- ### Key Lane Departure Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 2,292,914.
  - Driver age is distributed broadly across all age groups under 45; male drivers account for 62% of all crashes and 81% of fatal crashes.
  - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 4% of crashes and resulted in 50% of fatalities.
  - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 5% of crashes and resulted in 34% of fatalities.
  - 31% of crashes occurred along City Streets with most of the remainder occurring on State and US Routes.
  - Passenger car accounted for 38% of motor vehicles involved in lane departure crashes.
  - 33% of crashes occurred at night with 52% of fatalities.
