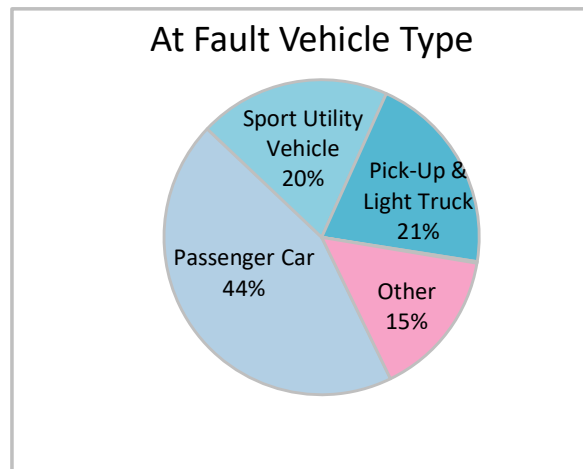
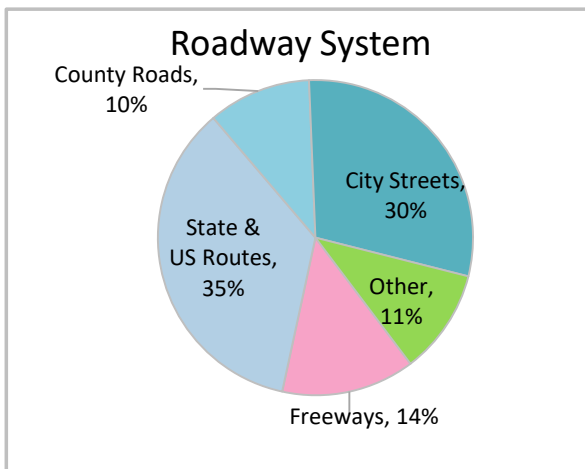
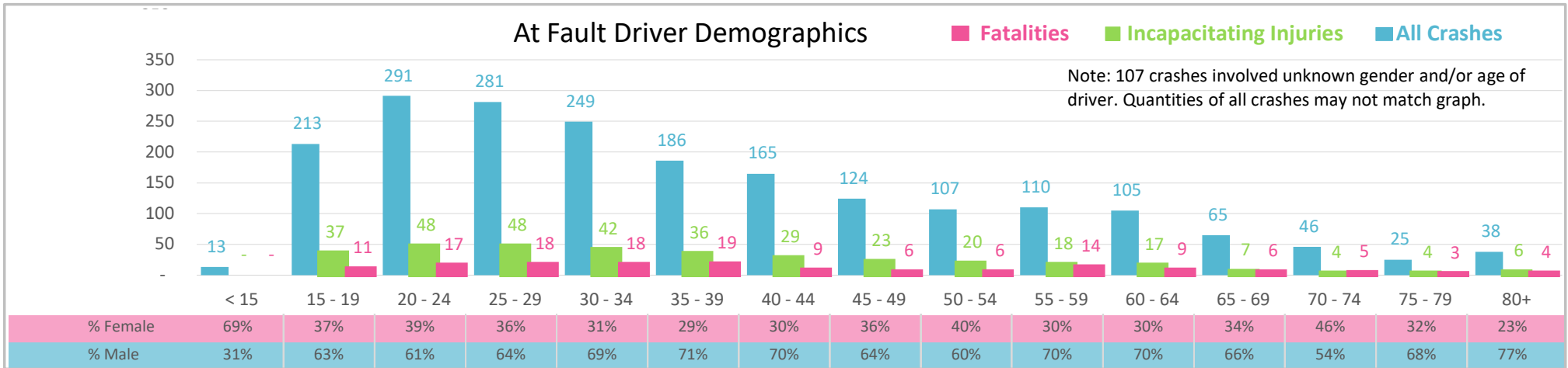

- ### Key Occupant Protection Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 2,292,914.
  - 49% of crashes involved drivers under 35; male drivers account for 66% of all crashes and 84% of fatalities.
  - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 14% of crashes and resulted in 42% of fatalities.
  - 35% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on City Streets.
  - Passenger car accounted for 44% of motor vehicles involved in occupant protection crashes.
  - 43% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 55% of fatalities.
