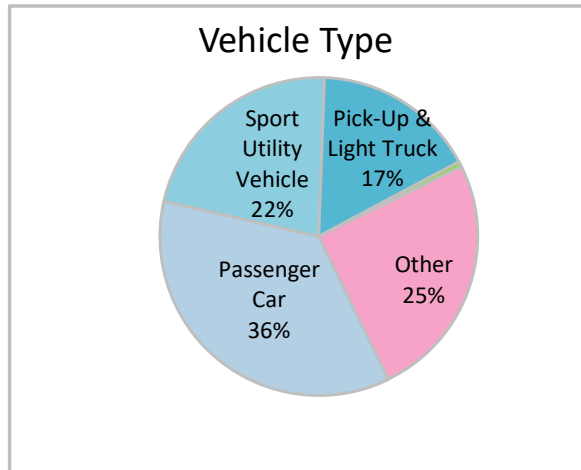
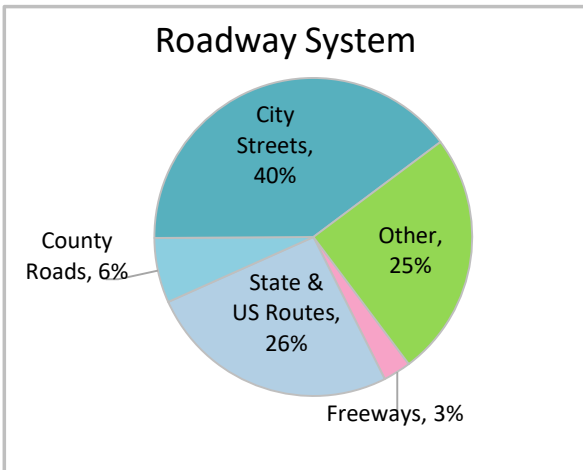
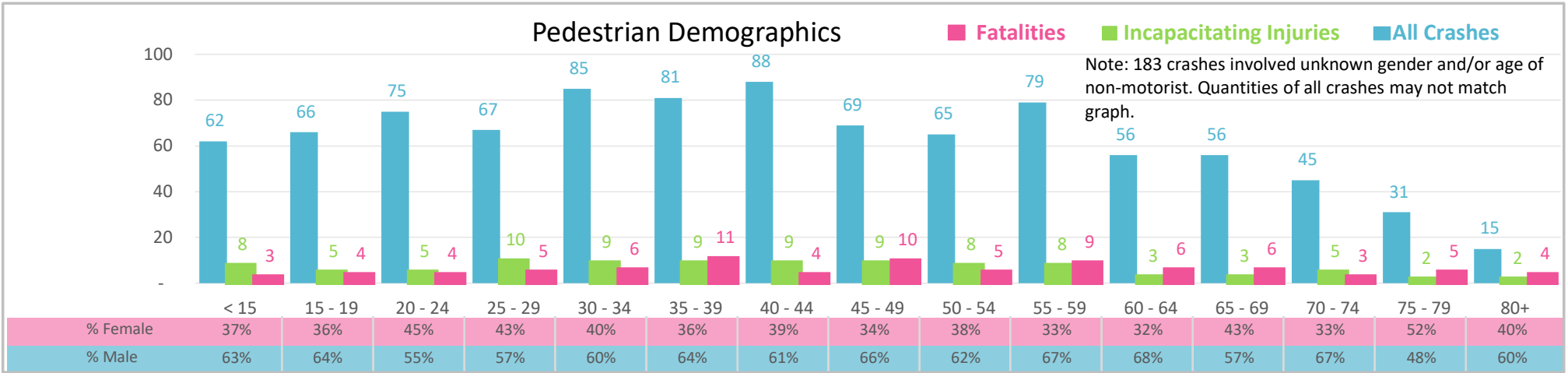

*NOTE: Crash severity is determined from the highest injury type in the crash (i.e. if a crash had both a fatal and a serious it is determined to be a fatal crash).



- ### Key Pedestrian Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 2,292,914.
 - Pedestrian age is distributed broadly across all age groups; male pedestrians account for 57% of all crashes and 64% of fatal crashes.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 3% of the crashes and resulted in 7 fatalities.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 2% of the crashes and resulted in 9 fatalities.
 - 40% of crashes occurred along City Streets with most of the remainder occurring on State and US routes.
 - Passenger car accounted for 36% of the motor vehicles involved in pedestrian crashes.
 - 42% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 80% of fatalities.
