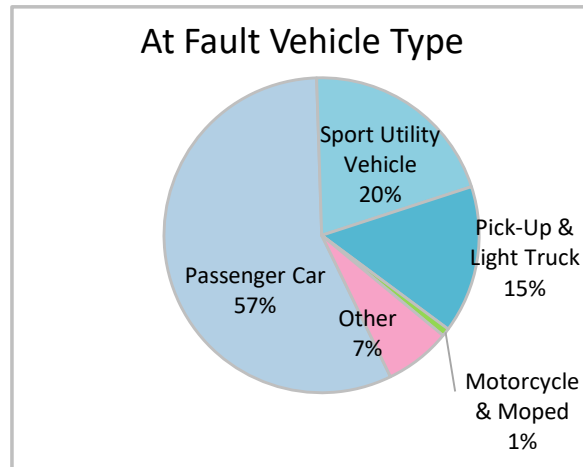
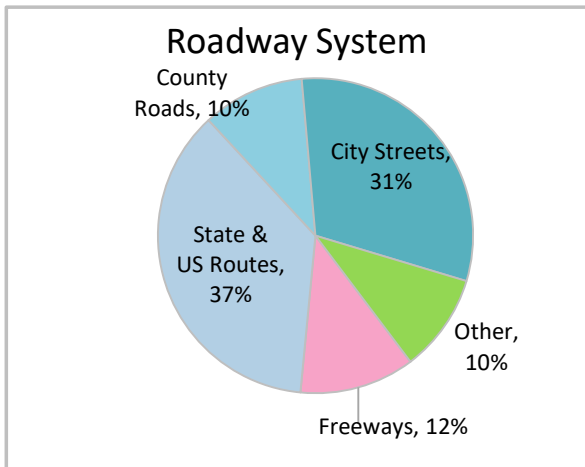
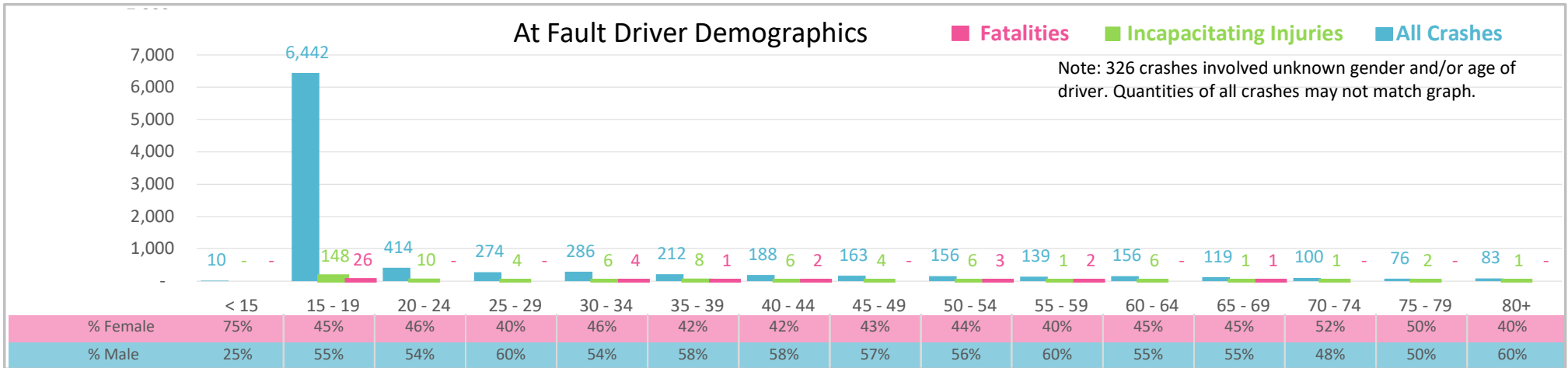

- ### Key Teen Driver Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 2,292,914.
 - 71% of crashes caused by drivers under 30; male drivers account for 55% of all crashes and 79% of fatalities.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 3% of crashes and resulted in 49% of fatalities.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 1% of crashes and resulted in 8 fatalities.
 - 37% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on City Streets.
 - Passenger car accounted for 57% of motor vehicles involved in teen driver crashes.
 - 28% of crashes occurred at night with 46% of fatalities.
