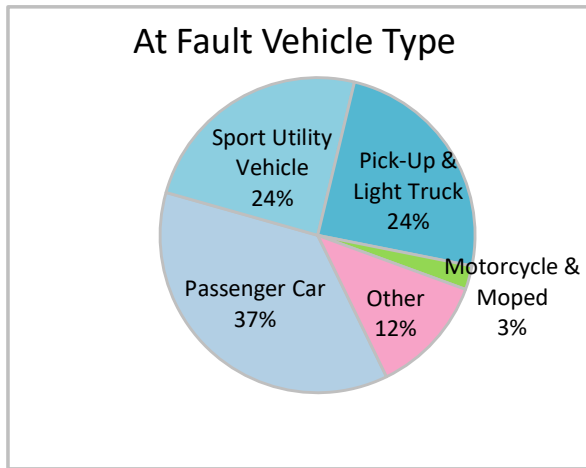
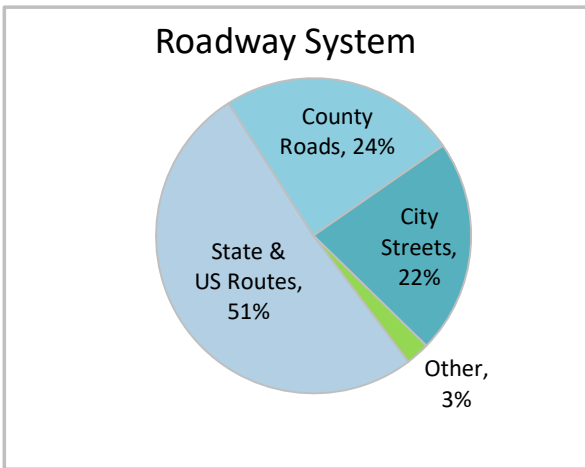
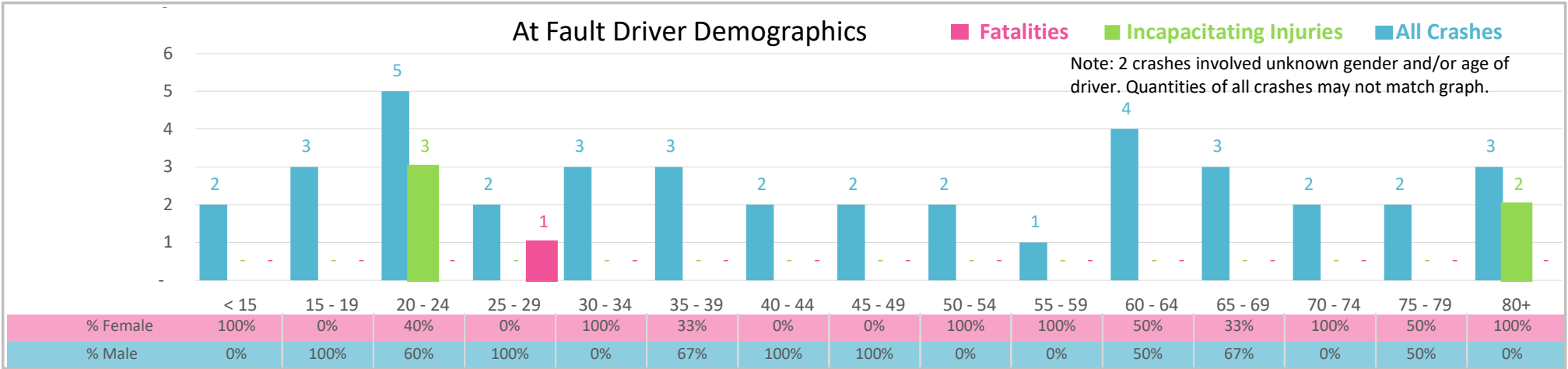

- ### Key Intersection Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 17,102.
  - Driver age is distributed broadly across all age groups; male drivers account for 51% of all crashes and the 1 fatality.
  - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 4 crashes.
  - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 4 crashes and resulted in 1 fatality.
  - 51% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on County Roads.
  - Passenger car accounted for 37% of motor vehicles involved in intersection crashes.
  - 24% of crashes occurred at night.
