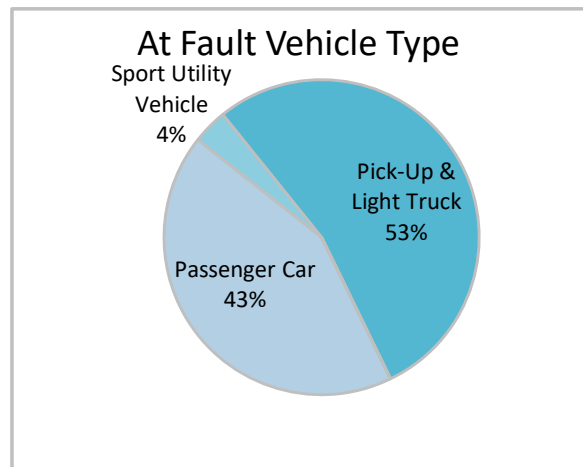
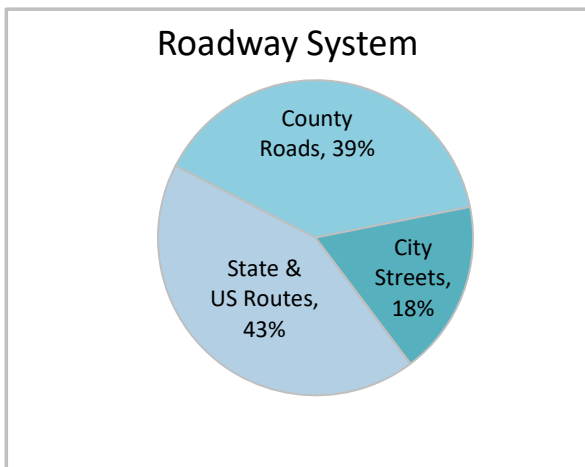
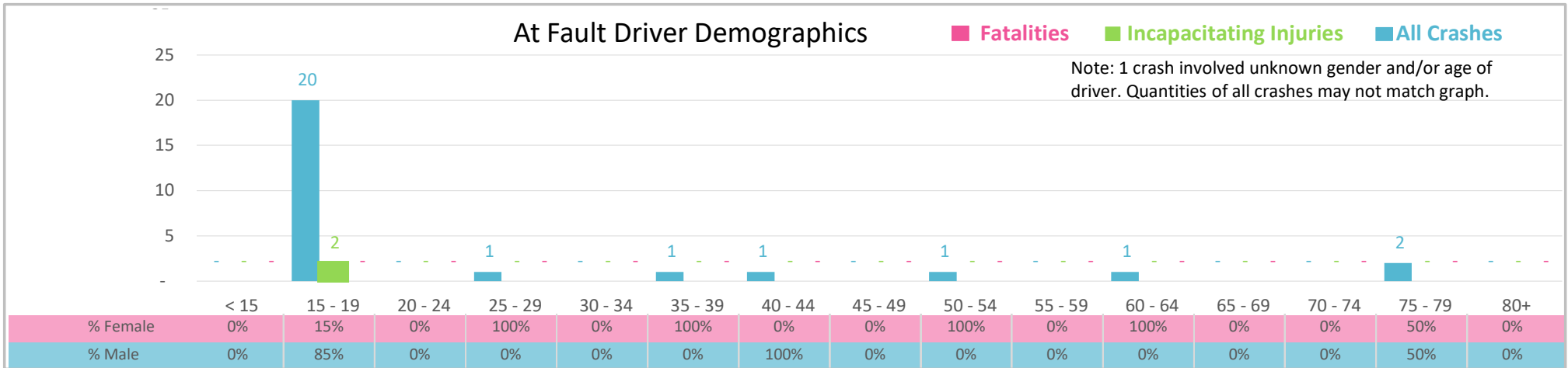

- ### Key Teen Driver Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 17,102.
 - 71% of crashes involved drivers under 20; male drivers account for 70% of all crashes.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 4 crashes.
 - Intoxication was not noted as a factor in any of the crashes.
 - 43% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on County Roads.
 - Passenger car accounted for 43% of motor vehicles involved in teen driver crashes.
 - 36% of crashes occurred at night.
