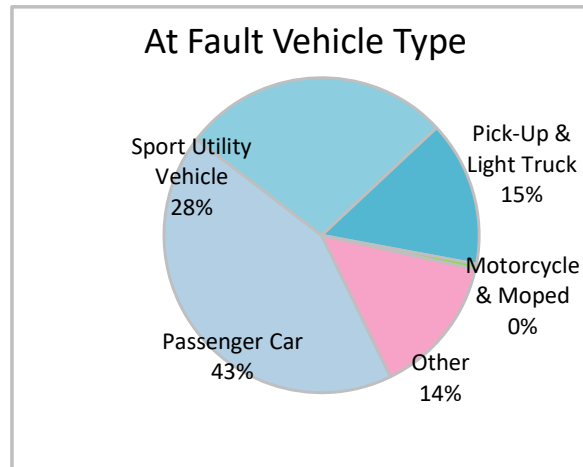
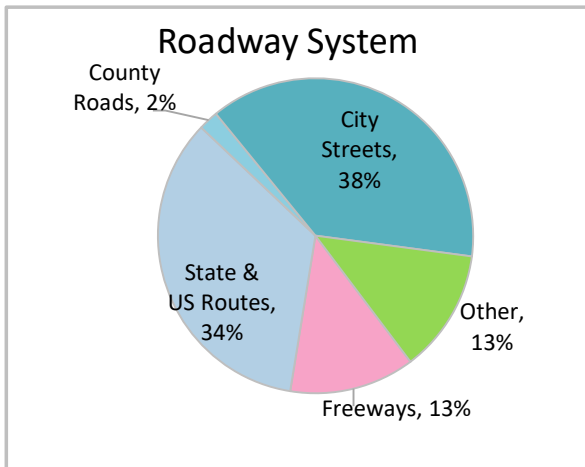
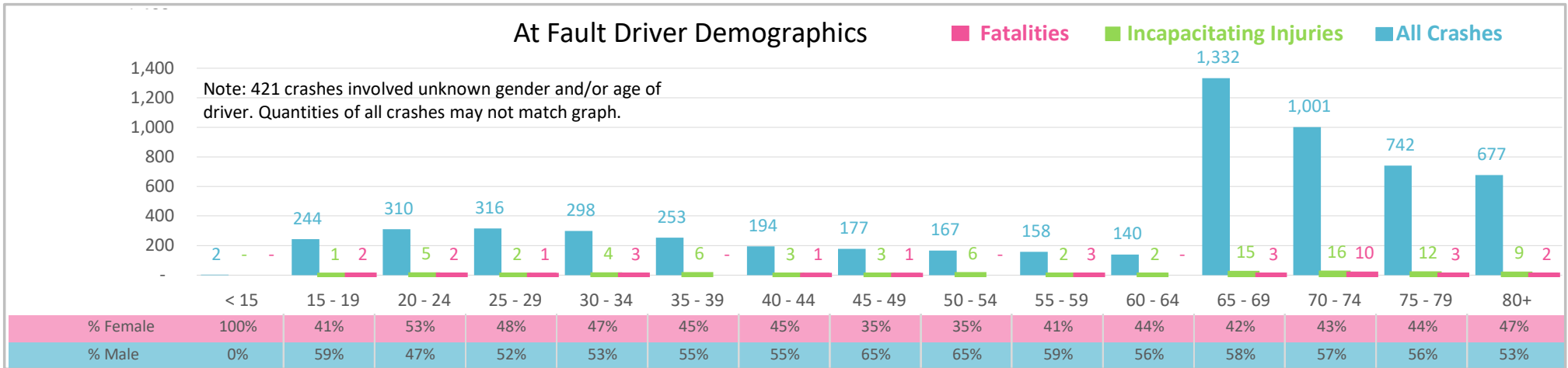

- ### Key Aging Road User Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 999,935.
 - 58% of crashes involved drivers 65 and older; male drivers account for 56% of all crashes and 63% of fatalities.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 2% of crashes and resulted in 9 fatalities.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 1% of crashes and resulted in 10 fatalities.
 - 38% of crashes occurred along City Streets with most of the remainder occurring on State and US Routes.
 - Passenger car accounted for 43% of motor vehicles involved in aging driver crashes.
 - 16% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 56% of fatalities.
