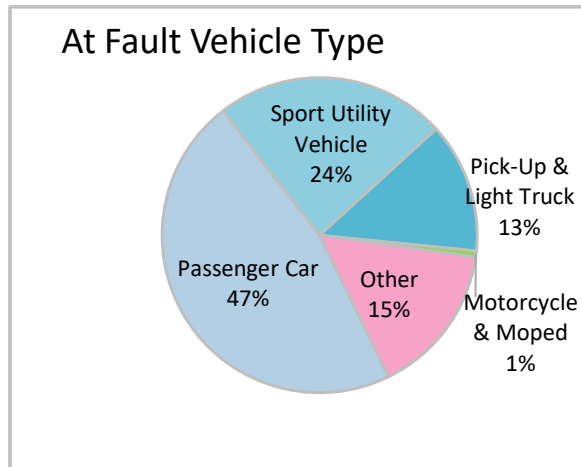
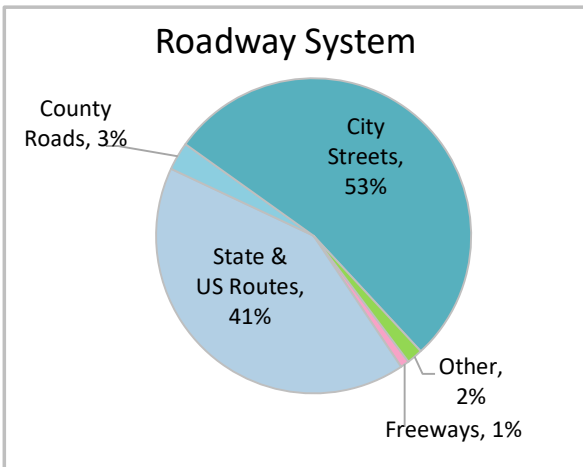
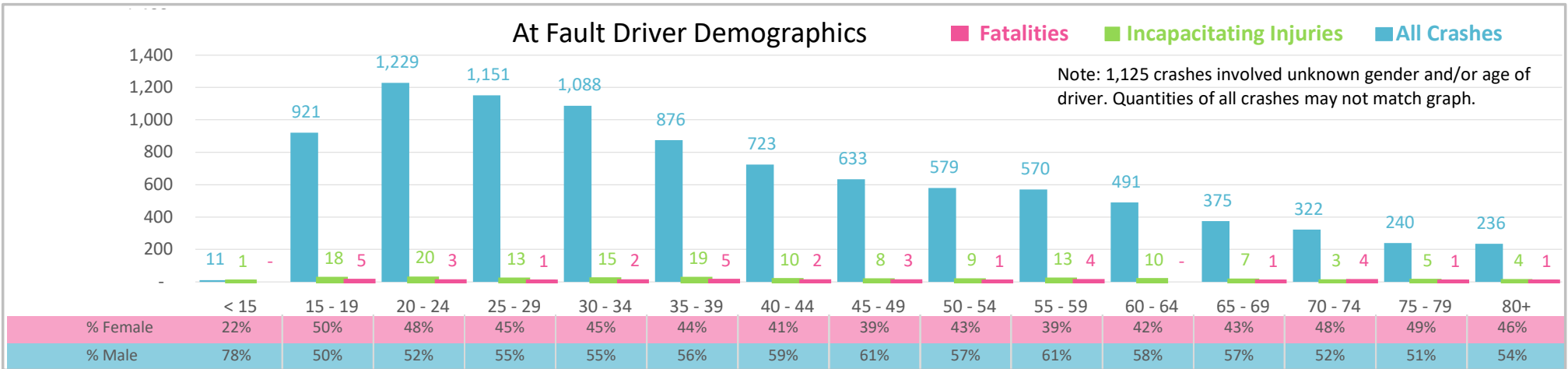

- ### Key Intersection Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 999,935.
 - 50% of crashes involved drivers under 40; male drivers account for 56% of all crashes and 73% of fatalities.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 2% of crashes and resulted in 31% of fatalities.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 2% of crashes and resulted in 43% of fatalities.
 - 53% of crashes occurred along City Streets with most of the remainder occurring on State and US Routes.
 - Passenger car accounted for 47% of motor vehicles involved in intersection crashes.
 - 27% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 69% of fatalities.
