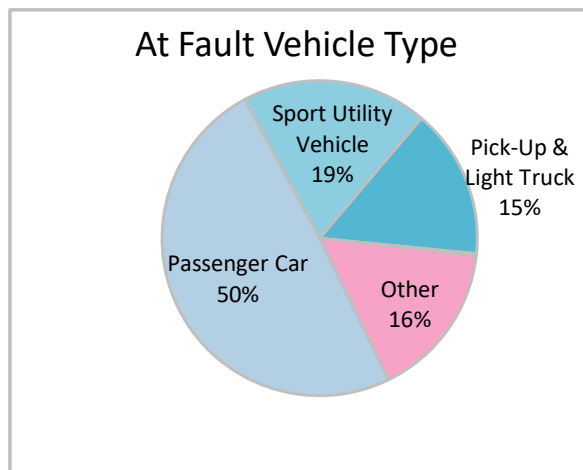
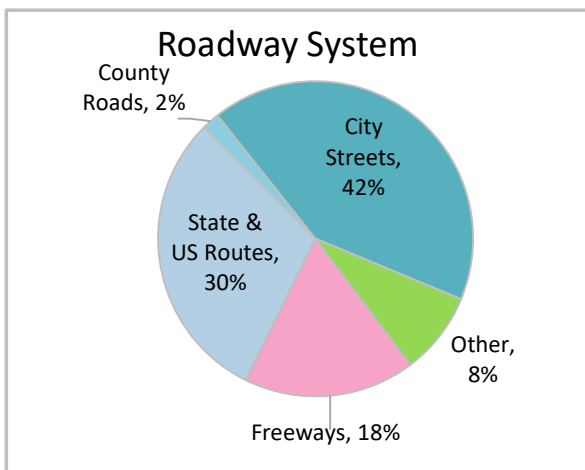
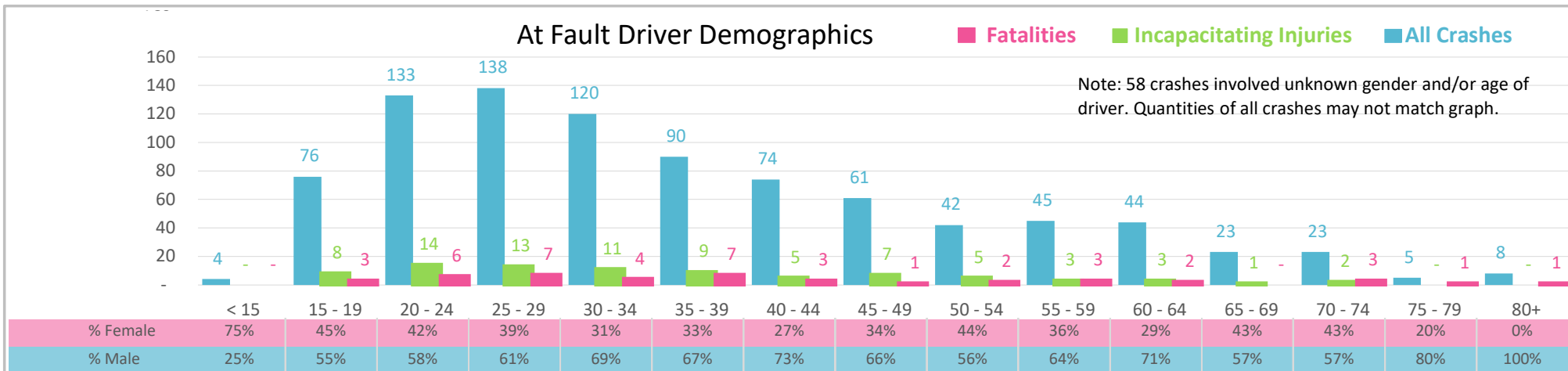

- ### Key Occupant Protection Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 999,935.
  - 50% of crashes involved drivers under 35; male drivers account for 63% of all crashes and 79% of fatalities.
  - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 12% of crashes and resulted in 60% of fatalities.
  - 42% of crashes occurred along City Streets with most of the remainder occurring on State and US Routes.
  - Passenger car accounted for 50% of motor vehicles involved in occupant protection crashes.
  - 41% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 67% of fatalities.
