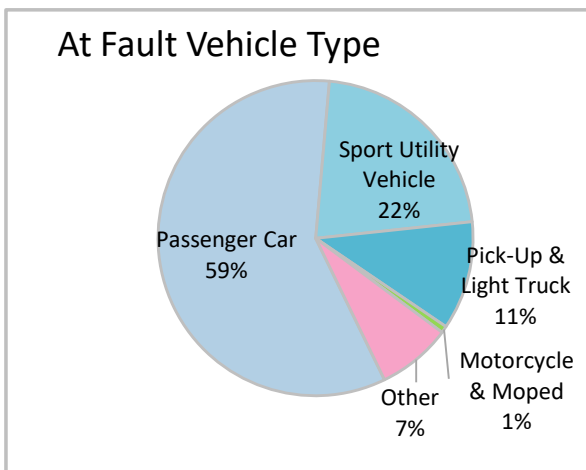
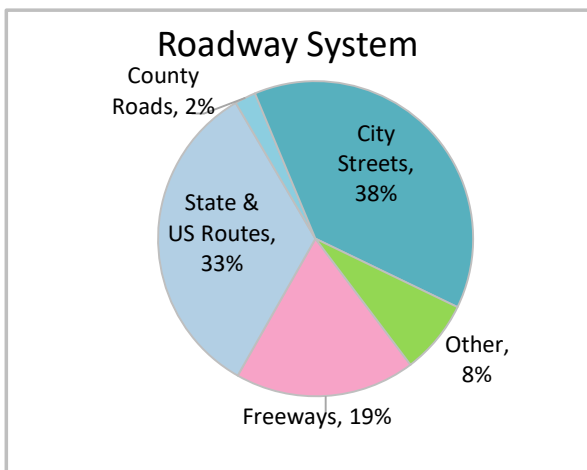
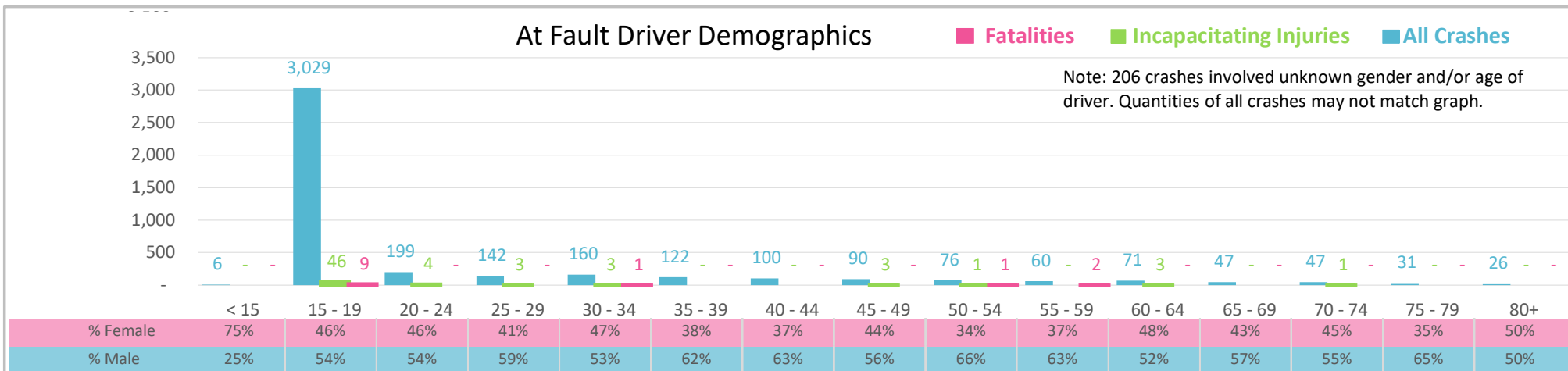

- ### Key Teen Driver Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 999,935.
 - 69% of crashes involved drivers under 20; male drivers account for 55% of all crashes and 9 fatalities.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 2% of crashes and resulted in 5 fatalities.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 1% of crashes and resulted in 3 fatalities.
 - 38% of crashes occurred along City Streets with most of the remainder occurring on State and US Routes.
 - Passenger car accounted for 59% of motor vehicles involved in teen driver crashes.
 - 28% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 85% of fatalities.
