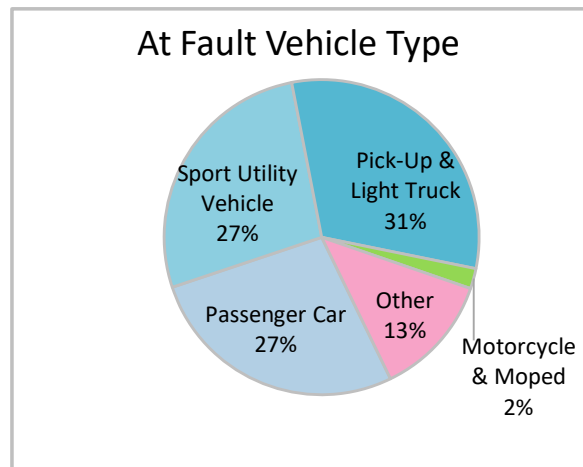
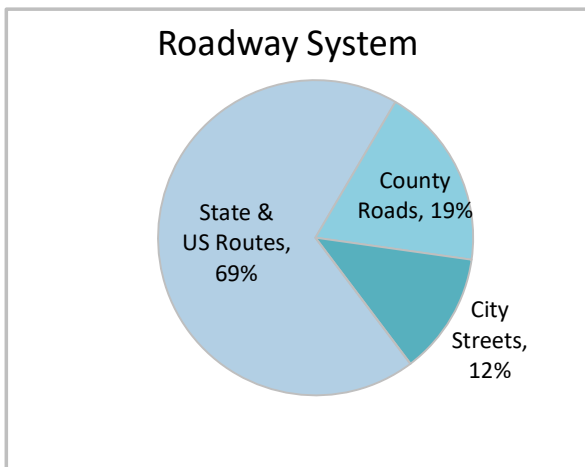
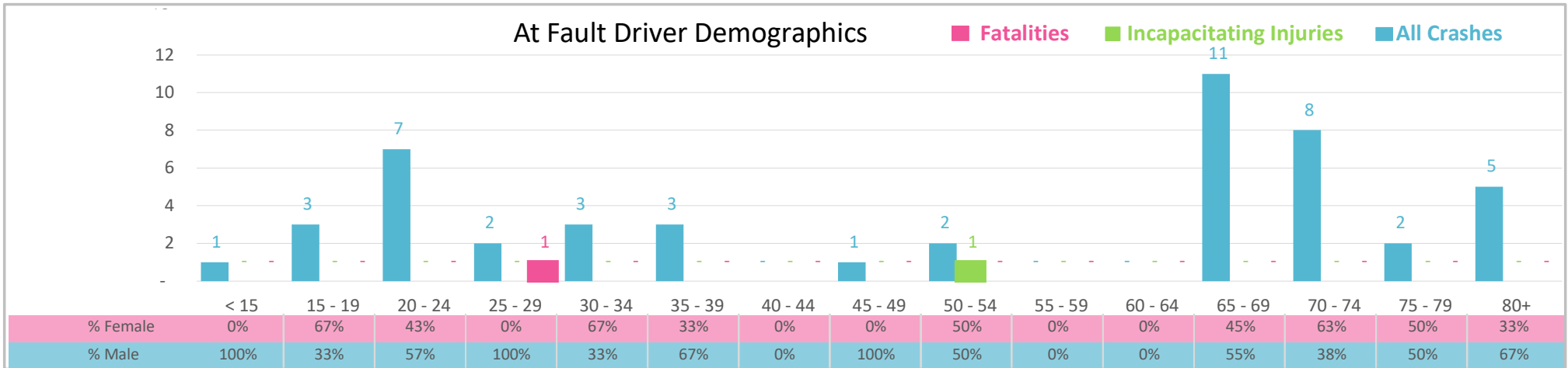

- ### Key Aging Road User Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 18,360.
  - 54% of crashes involved drivers 65 and older; male drivers account for 56% of all crashes and the 1 fatality.
  - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 6 crashes.
  - Intoxication was not noted as a factor in any of the crashes.
  - 69% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on County Roads.
  - Pick-up and light truck accounted for 31% of motor vehicles involved in aging driver crashes.
  - 21% of crashes occurred at night.
