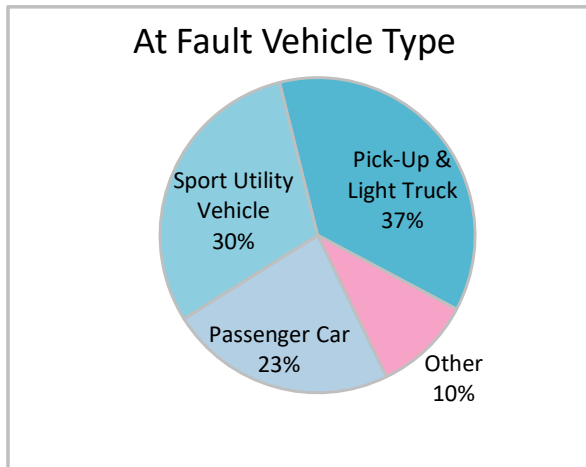
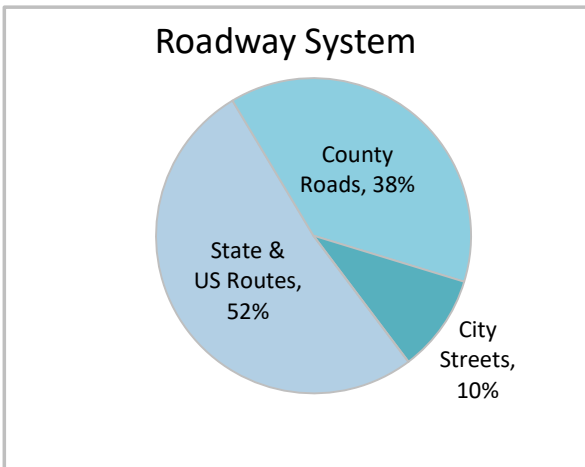
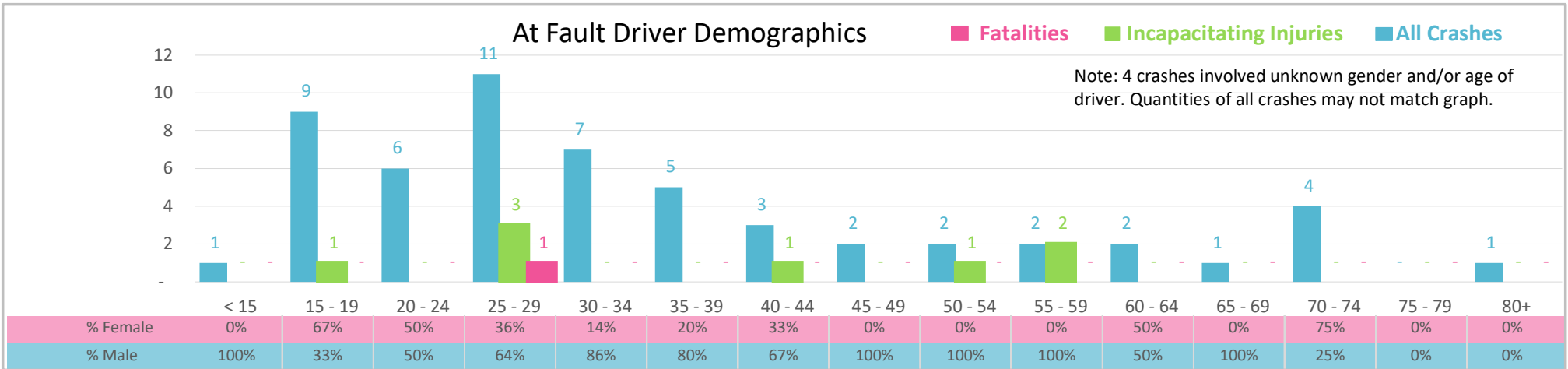

- ### Key Intersection Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 18,360.
  - 57% of crashes involved drivers under 35; male drivers account for 64% of all crashes and the 1 fatality.
  - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 7 crashes.
  - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 4 crashes.
  - 52% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on County Roads.
  - Pick-up and light truck accounted for 37% of motor vehicles involved in intersection crashes.
  - 28% of crashes occurred at night.
