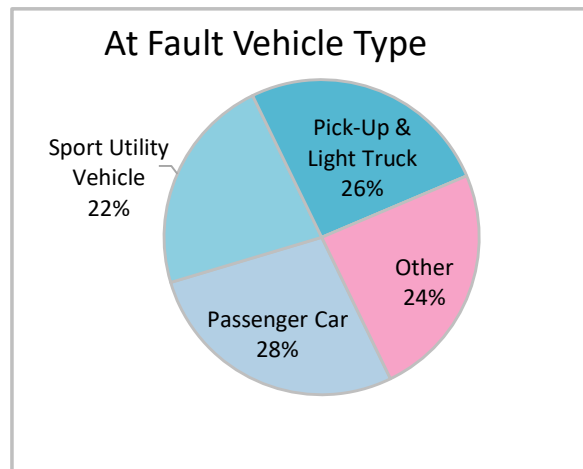
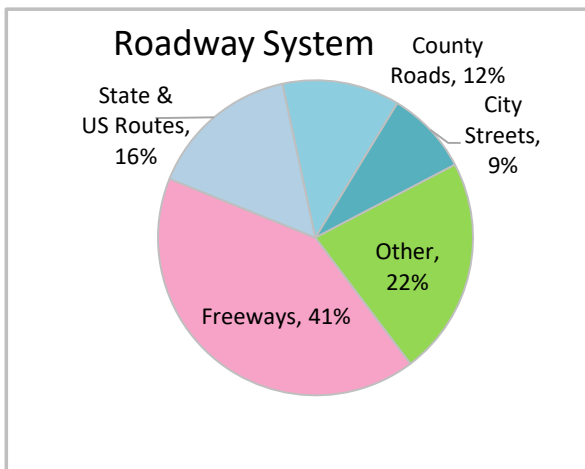
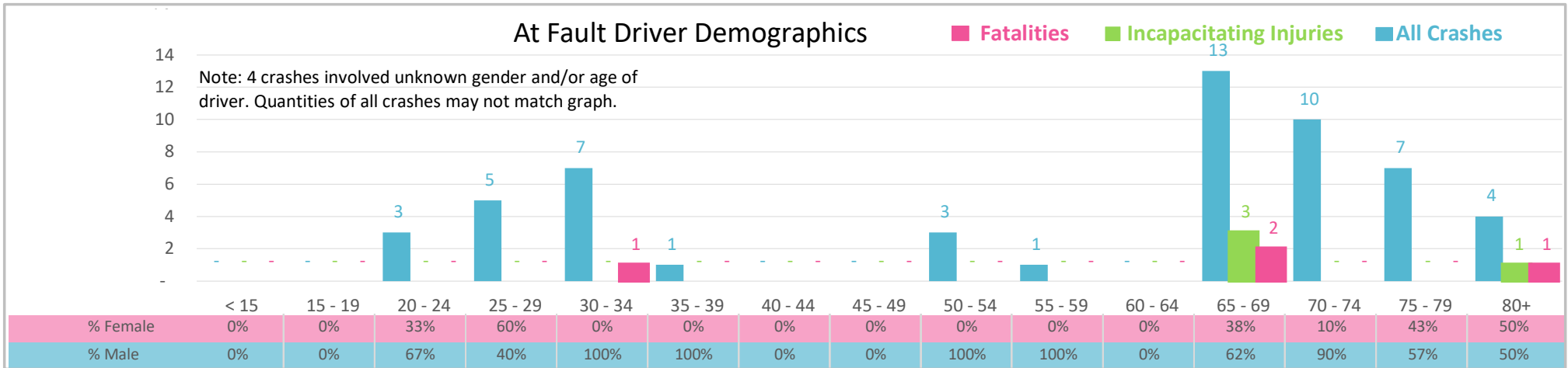

- ### Key Aging Road User Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 13,993.
 - 59% of crashes involved drivers 65 and older; male drivers accounted for 72% of crashes and 2 of 4 fatalities.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 5 crashes and resulted in 2 fatalities.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 3 crashes and resulted in 1 fatality.
 - 41% of crashes occurred along Freeways with most of the remainder occurring on Other roadway systems.
 - Passenger car accounted for 28% of motor vehicles involved in aging driver crashes.
 - 26% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 1 fatality.
