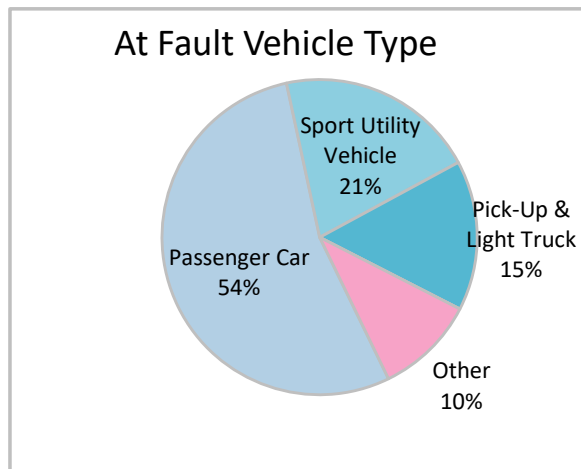
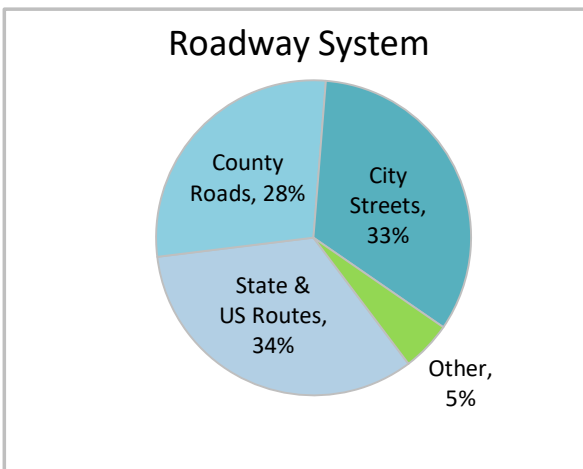
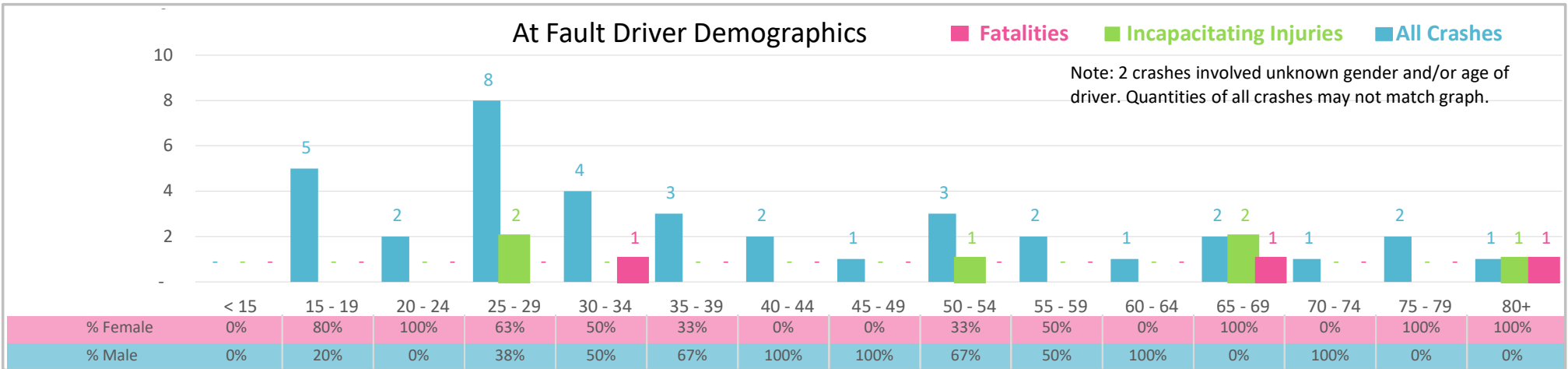

- ### Key Intersection Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 13,993.
 - Driver age is distributed broadly across all age groups; female drivers accounted for 57% of crashes and 2 fatalities.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 4 crashes and resulted in 2 fatalities.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 1 crash and 1 fatality.
 - 34% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on City Streets.
 - Passenger car accounted for 54% of motor vehicles involved in intersection crashes.
 - 31% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 1 fatality.
