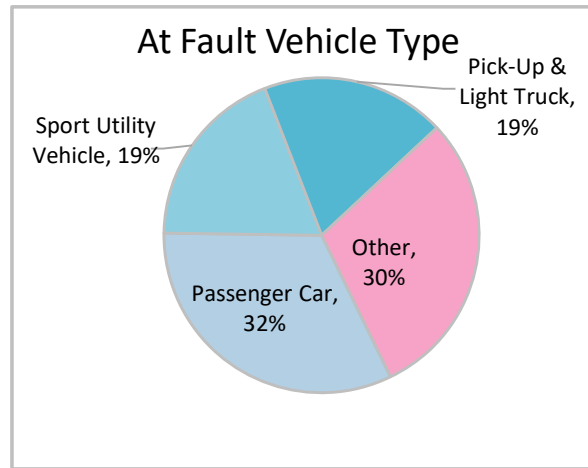
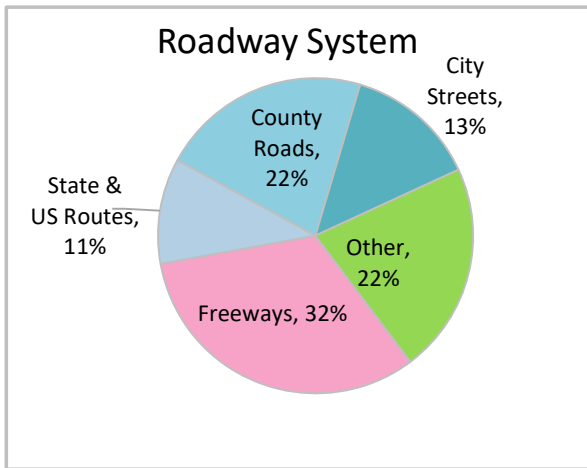
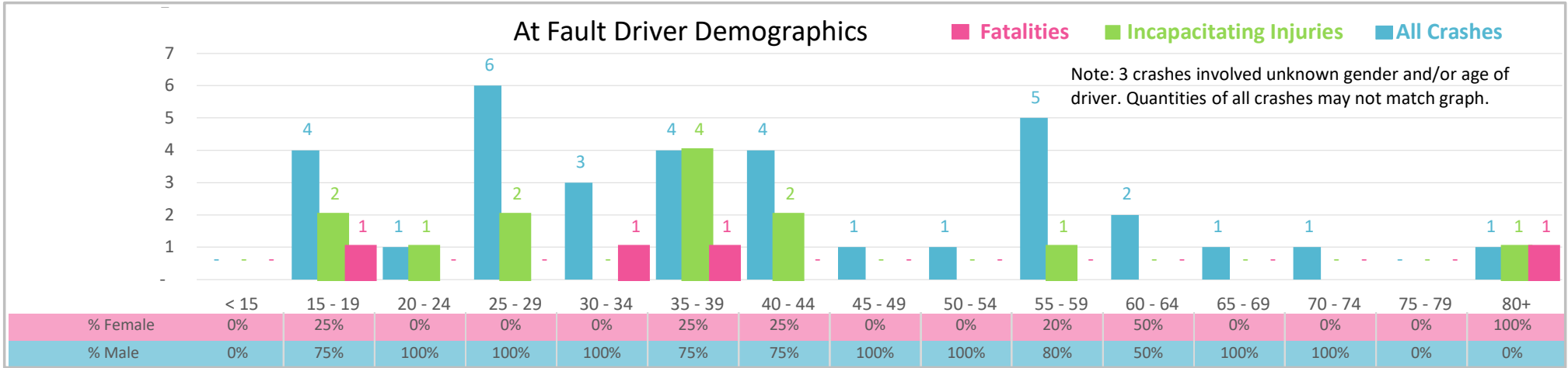

- ### Key Occupant Protection Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 13,993.
 - Driver age is distributed broadly across all age groups under 60; male drivers account for 82% of all crashes and 3 fatalities.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 1 crash and resulted in 1 fatality.
 - 32% of crashes occurred along Freeways with most of the remainder occurring on County Roads and Other roadway systems.
 - Passenger Car accounted for 32% of motor vehicles involved in occupant protection crashes.
 - 57% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 1 fatality.
