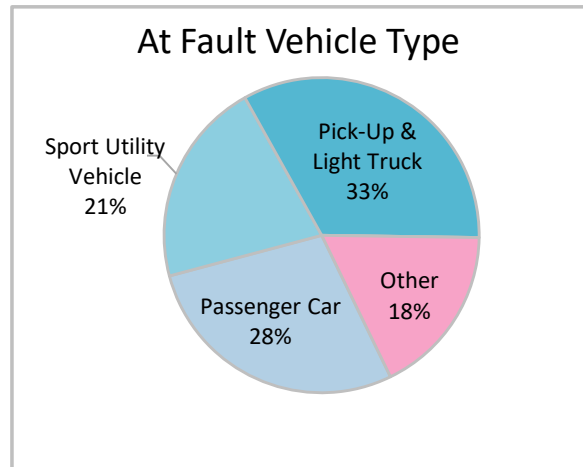
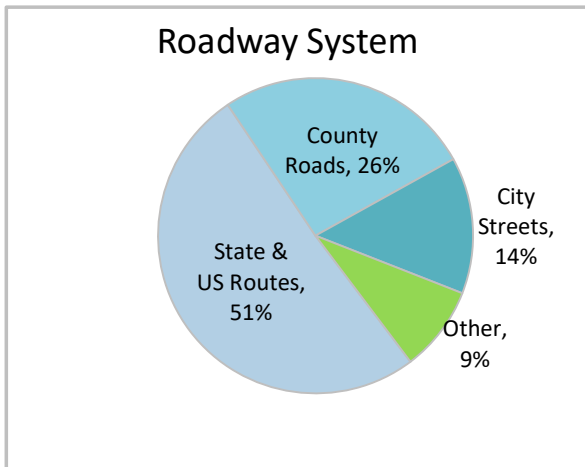
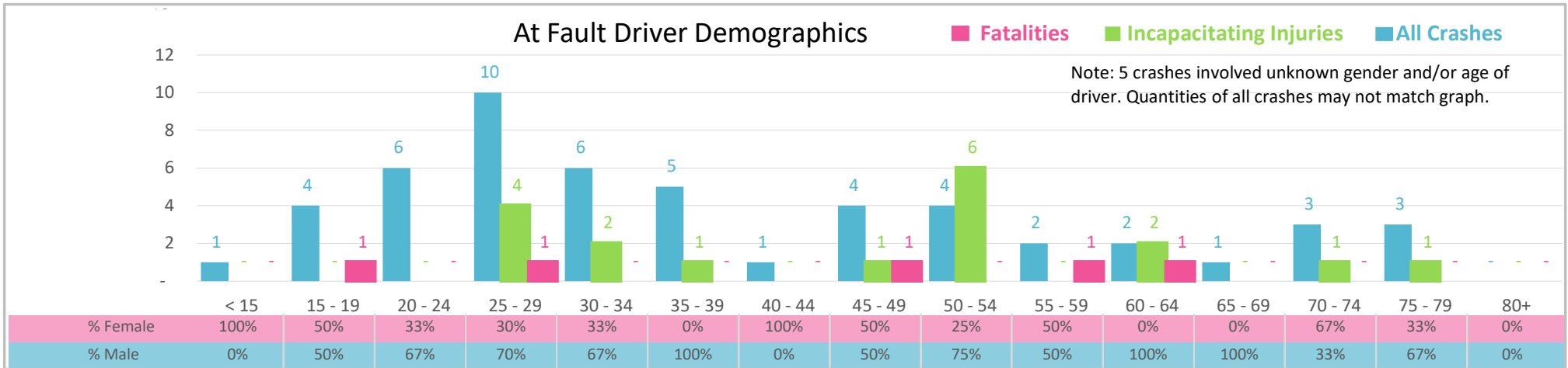

- ### Key Occupant Protection Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 44,158.
 - Driver age is distributed broadly across all age groups under 55; male drivers account for 66% of all crashes and 4 fatalities.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 9 crashes and 2 fatalities.
 - 51% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on County Roads.
 - Pick-up and light truck accounted for 33% of motor vehicles involved in occupant protection crashes.
 - 47% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 1 fatality.
