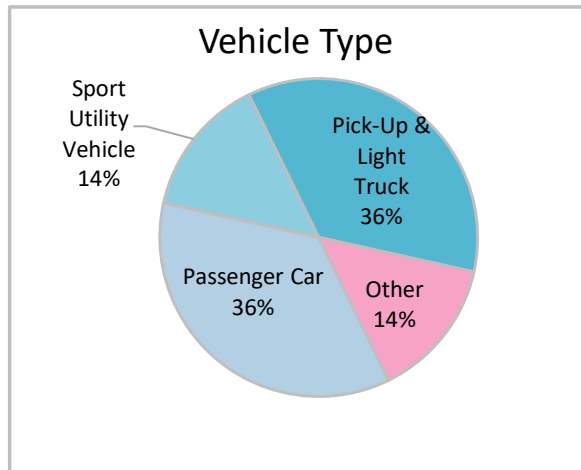
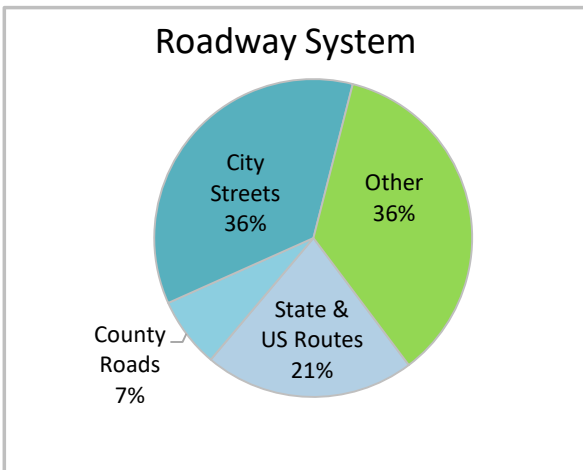
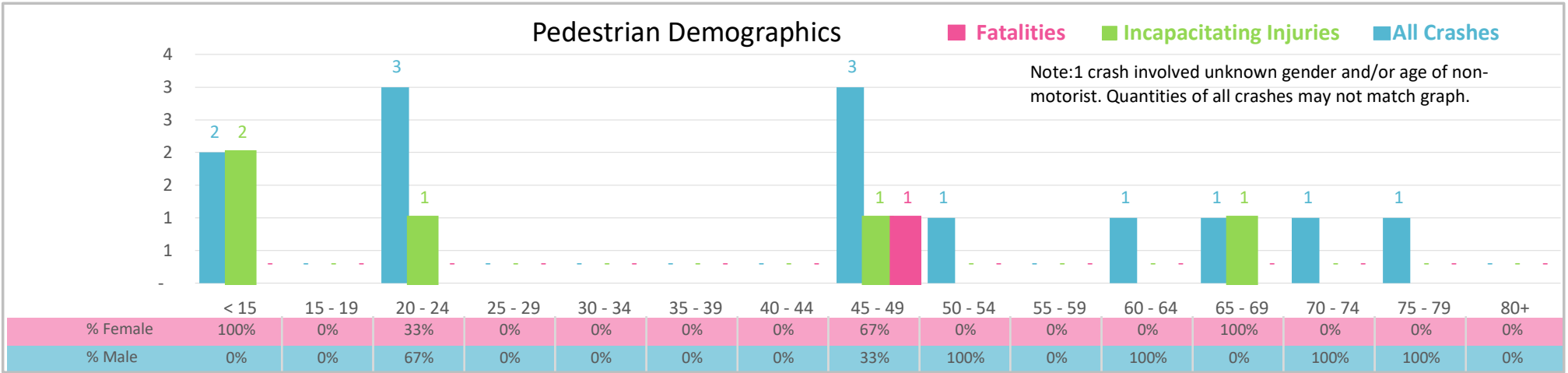

*NOTE: Crash severity is determined from the highest injury type in the crash (i.e. if a crash had both a fatal and a serious it is determined to be a fatal crash).



- ### Key Pedestrian Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 44,158.
 - Pedestrian age is distributed broadly across all age groups; male pedestrians account for 58% of all crashes and the 1 fatality.
 - Unrestrained occupant was not noted as a factor in any of the crashes.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 1 crash.
 - 36% of crashes occurred along City Streets and Other Roadway Systems with most of the remainder occurring on State and US Routes.
 - Pick-Up and Light Truck and Passenger car each accounted for 36% of the motor vehicles involved in pedestrian crashes.
 - 57% of crashes occurred at night.
