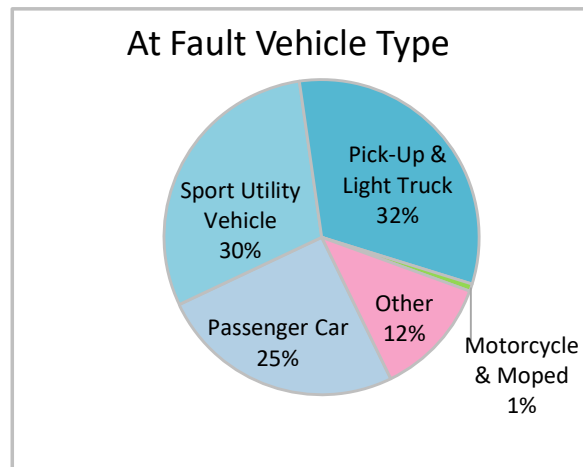
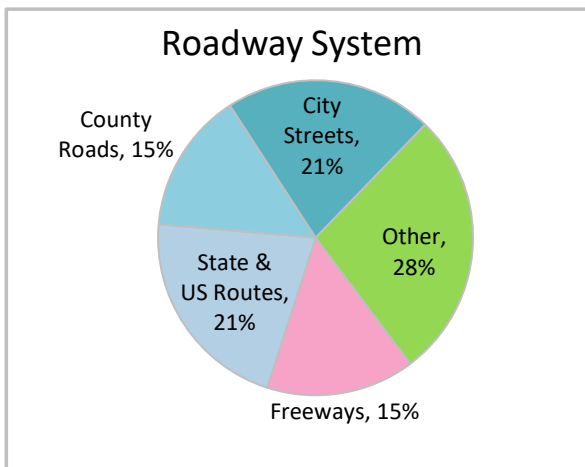
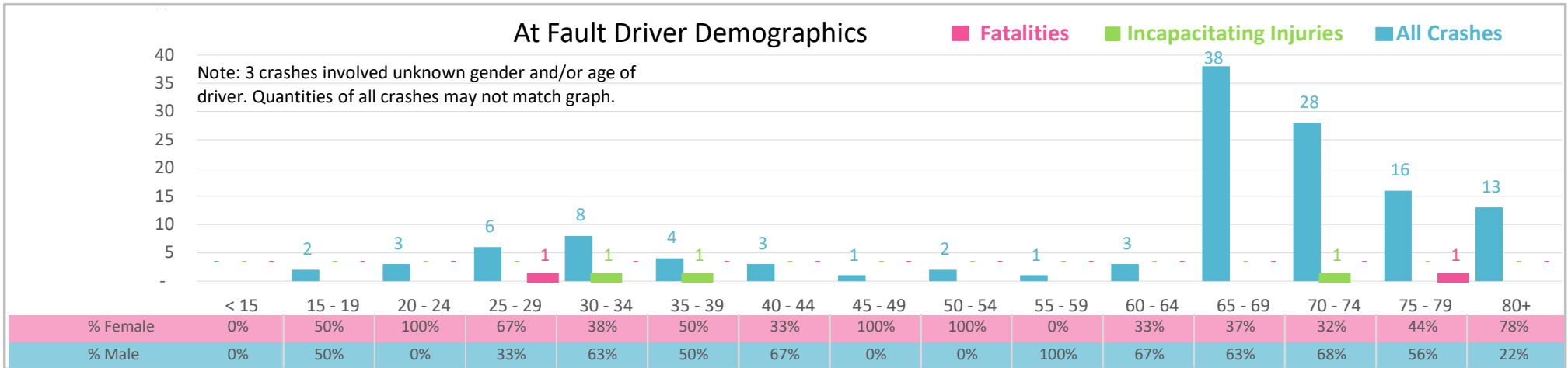

- ### Key Aging Road User Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 18,288.
 - 73% of crashes involved drivers 65 and older; male drivers account for 55% of all crashes and 1 of 2 fatalities.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 9 crashes.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 1 crash.
 - 28% of crashes occurred along Other roadway systems with most of the remainder occurring on City Streets and State and US Routes.
 - Pick-up and light truck accounted for 32% of motor vehicles involved in aging driver crashes.
 - 21% of crashes occurred at night resulting in the 2 fatalities.
