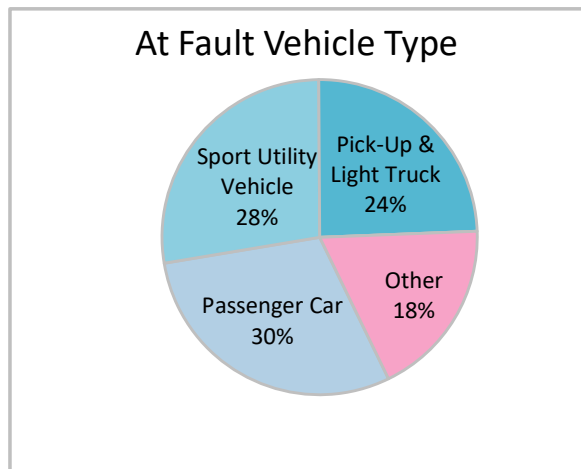
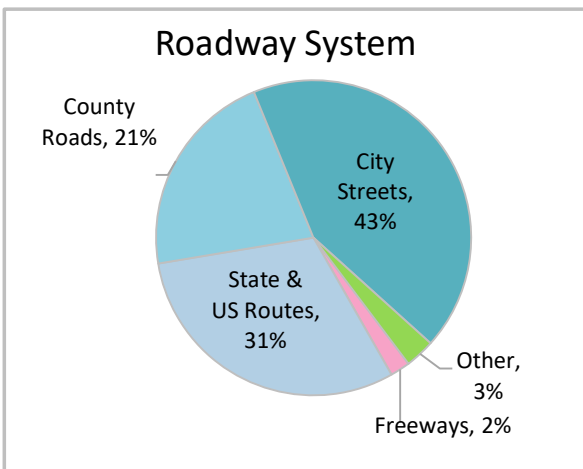
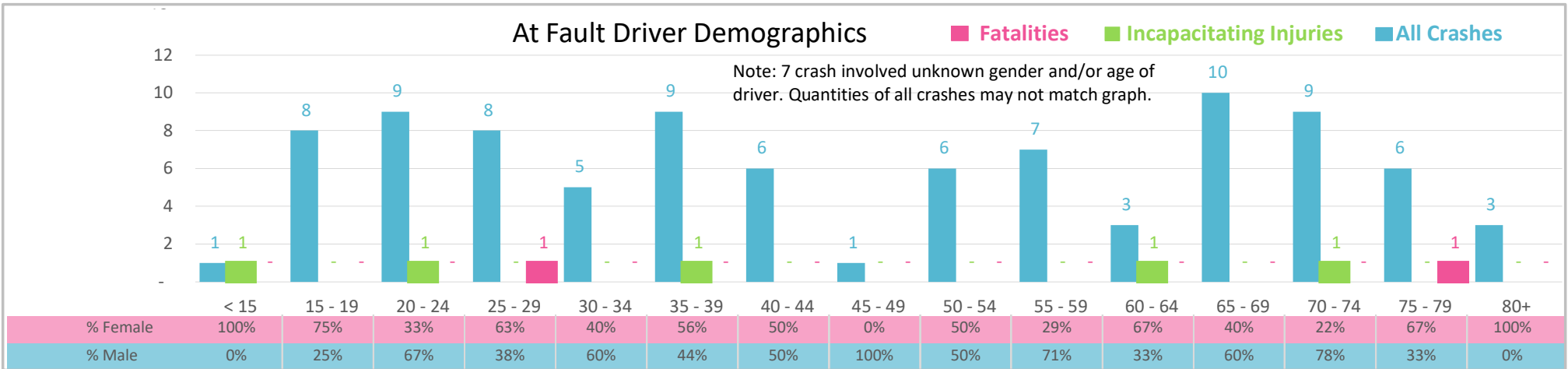

- ### Key Intersection Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 18,288.
  - 41% of crashes involved drivers under 40; male drivers account for 51% of all crashes and 1 fatality.
  - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 6 crashes.
  - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 2 crashes.
  - 43% of crashes occurred along City Streets with most of the remainder occurring on State and US Routes.
  - Passenger car accounted for 30% of motor vehicles involved in intersection crashes.
  - 23% of crashes occurred at night resulting in the 2 fatalities.
