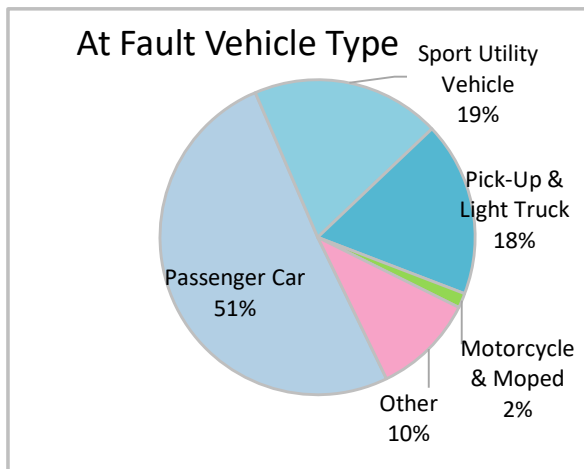
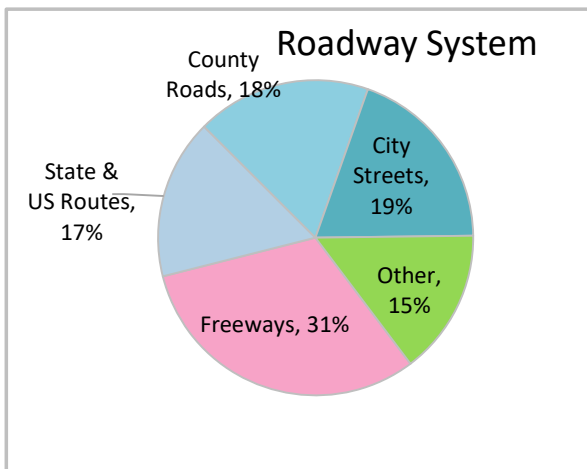
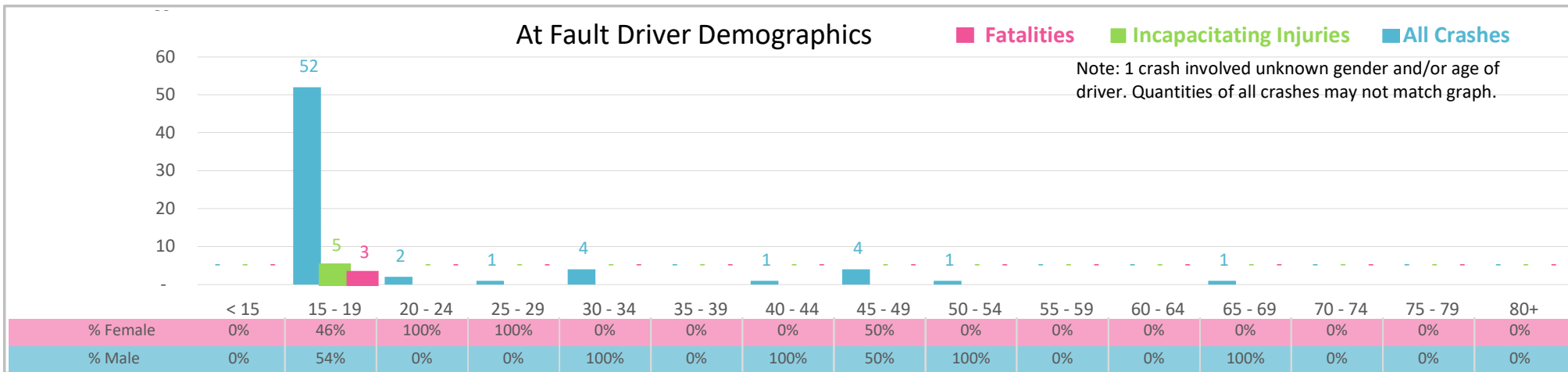

- ### Key Teen Driver Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 18,288.
  - 78% of crashes involved drivers under 20; male drivers account for 56% of all crashes and the 3 fatalities.
  - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 2 crashes.
  - Intoxication was not noted as a factor in any of the crashes.
  - 31% of crashes occurred along Freeways with most of the remainder occurring on City Streets.
  - Passenger car accounted for 51% of motor vehicles involved in teen driver crashes.
  - 40% of crashes occurred at night.
