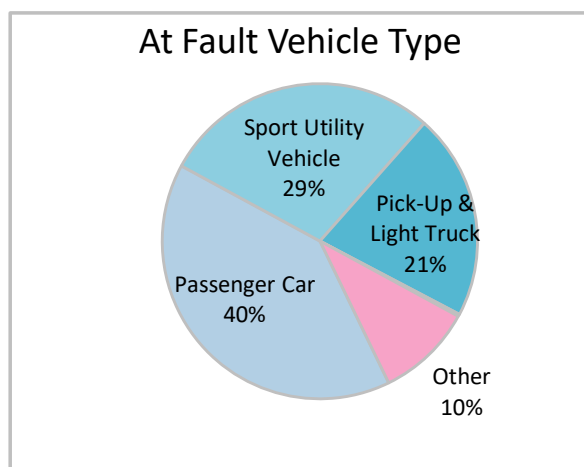
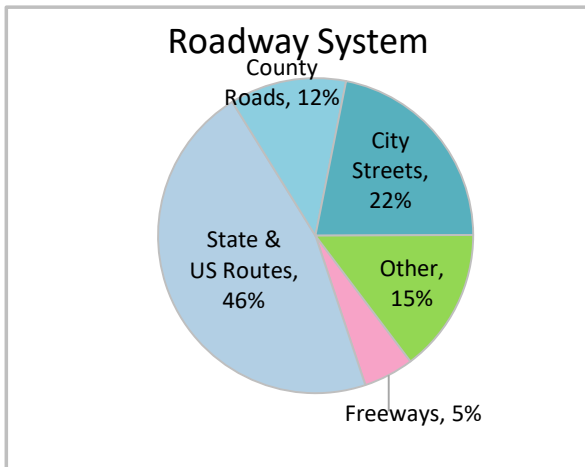
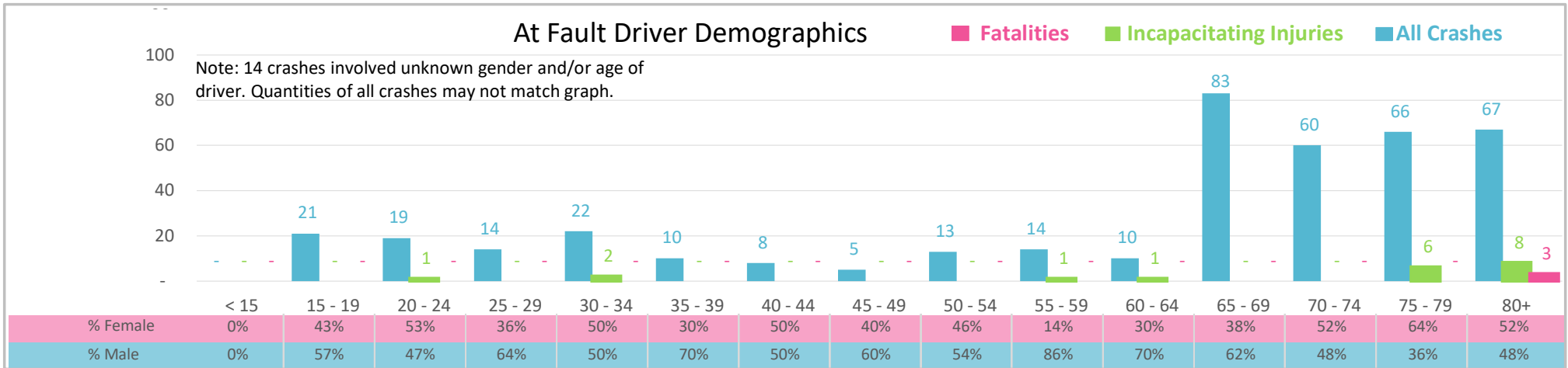

- ### Key Aging Road User Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 94,189.
 - 65% of crashes involved drivers 65 and older; male drivers account for 53% of all crashes and 2 of 4 fatalities.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 3% of crashes.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 5 crashes.
 - 46% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on City Streets.
 - Passenger car accounted for 40% of motor vehicles involved in aging driver crashes.
 - 14% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 1 fatality.
