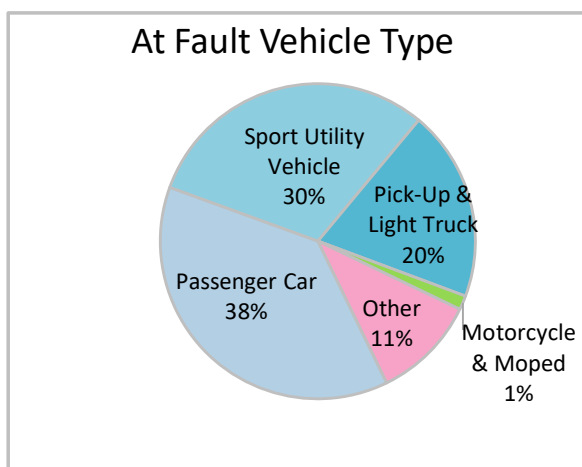
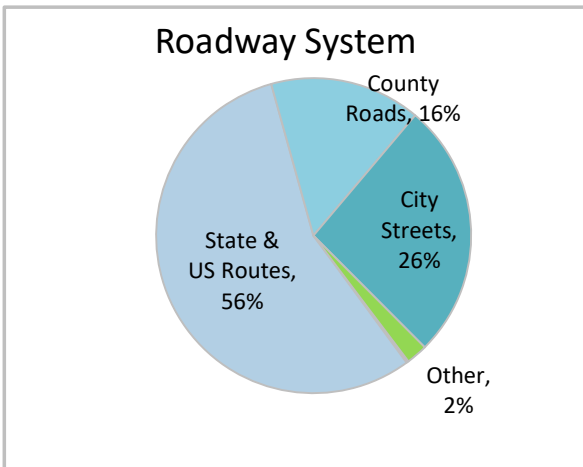
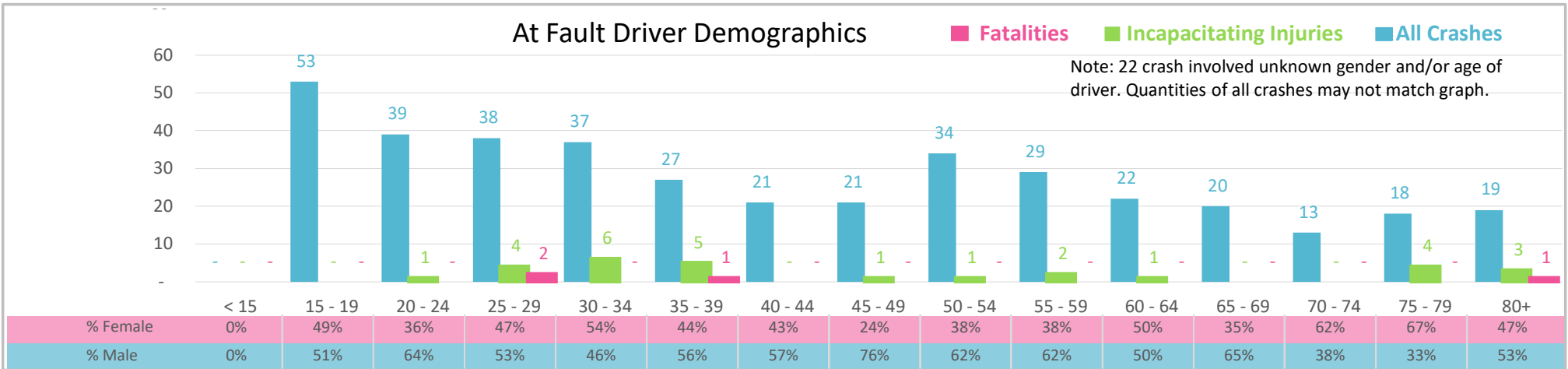

- ### Key Intersection Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 94,189.
 - 47% of crashes involved drivers under 40; male drivers account for 55% of all crashes and 2 fatalities.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 3% of crashes.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 3% of crashes.
 - 56% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on City Streets.
 - Passenger car accounted for 38% of motor vehicles involved in intersection crashes.
 - 26% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 2 fatalities.
