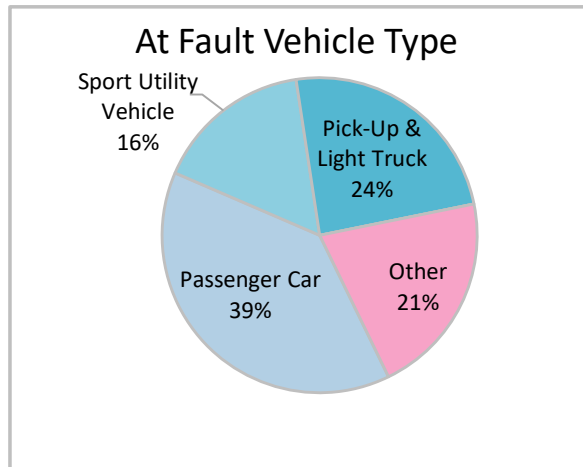
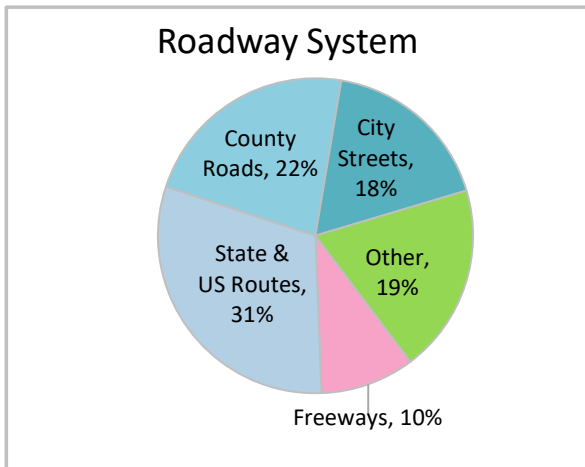
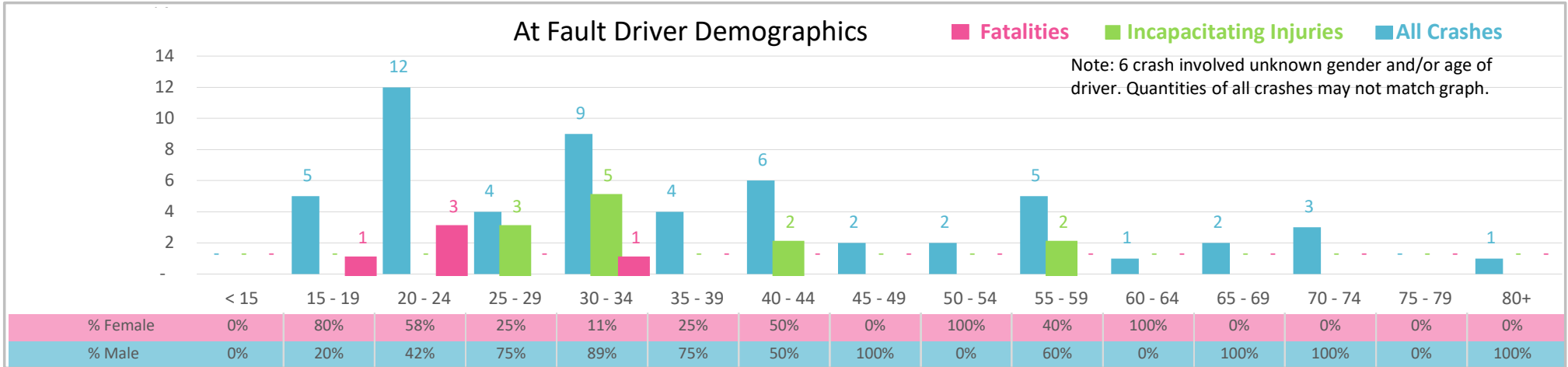

- ### Key Occupant Protection Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 94,189.
  - Driver age is distributed broadly across all age groups under 45; male drivers account for 61% of all crashes and 4 fatalities.
  - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 4 crashes.
  - 31% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on County Roads.
  - Passenger car accounted for 39% of motor vehicles involved in occupant protection crashes.
  - 29% of crashes occurred at night resulting 3 fatalities.
