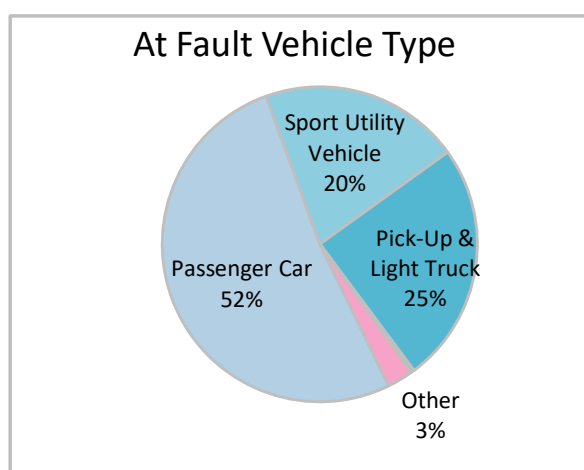
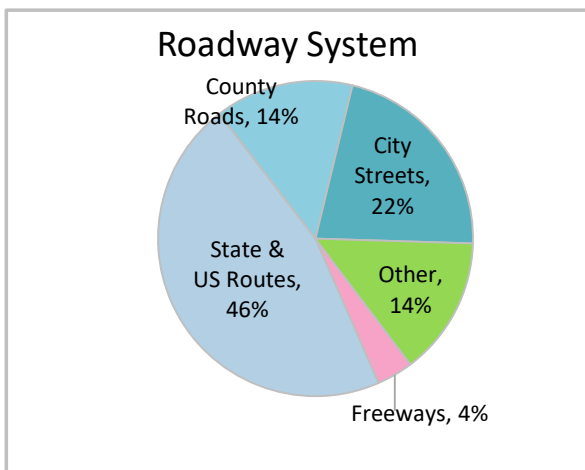
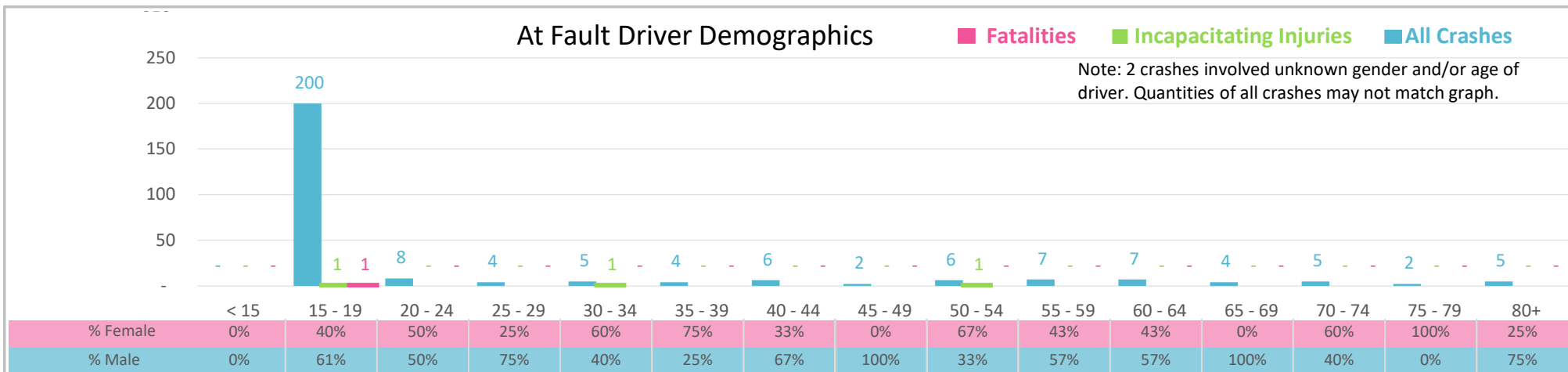

- ### Key Teen Driver Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 94,189.
 - 75% of crashes involved drivers under 20; male drivers account for 59% of all crashes.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 6 crashes resulting in 1 fatality.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 6 crashes.
 - 46% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on City Streets.
 - Passenger car accounted for 52% of motor vehicles involved in teen driver crashes.
 - 25% of crashes occurred at night.
