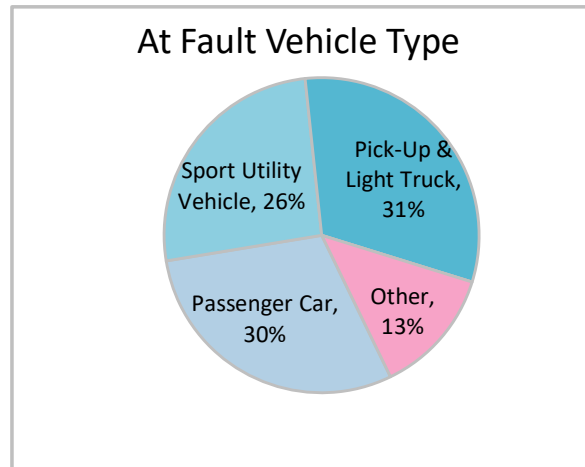
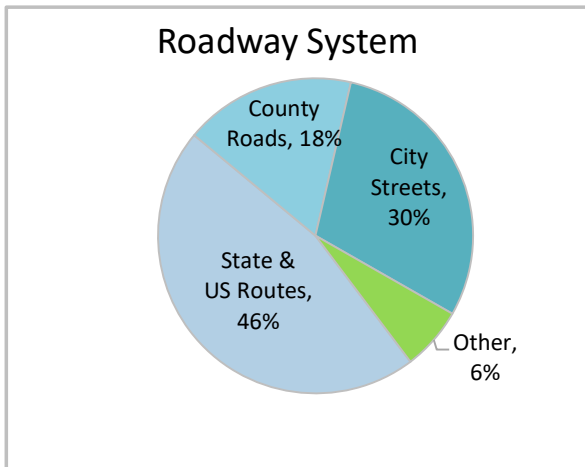
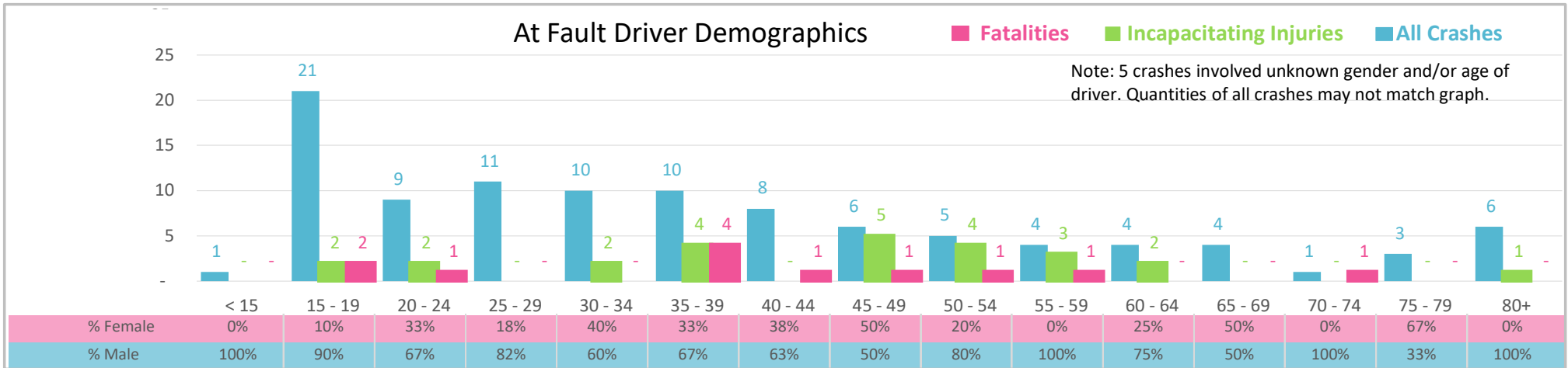

- ### Key Occupant Protection Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 74,167.
  - Driver age is distributed broadly across all age groups; male drivers account for 73% of all crashes and 8 fatalities.
  - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 14 crashes and 3 fatalities.
  - 46% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on City Streets.
  - Types of motor vehicles involved in occupant protection crashes were generally equally distributed with highest involving pick-up and light trucks, 31%.
  - 44% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 4 fatalities.
