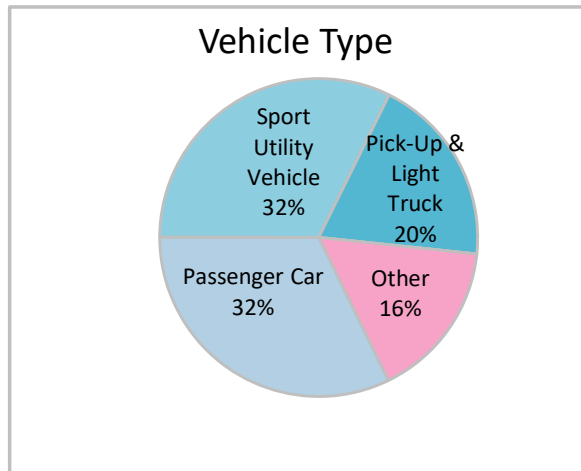
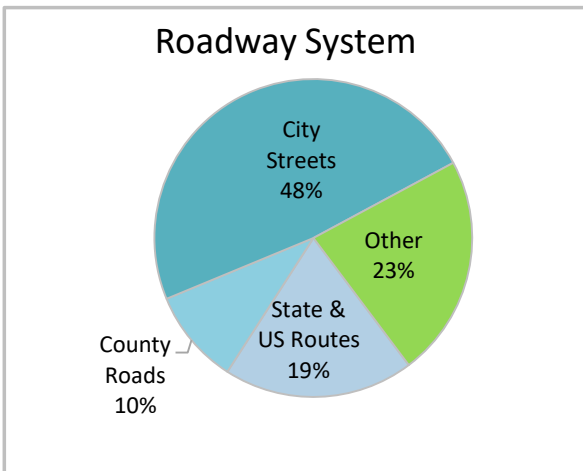
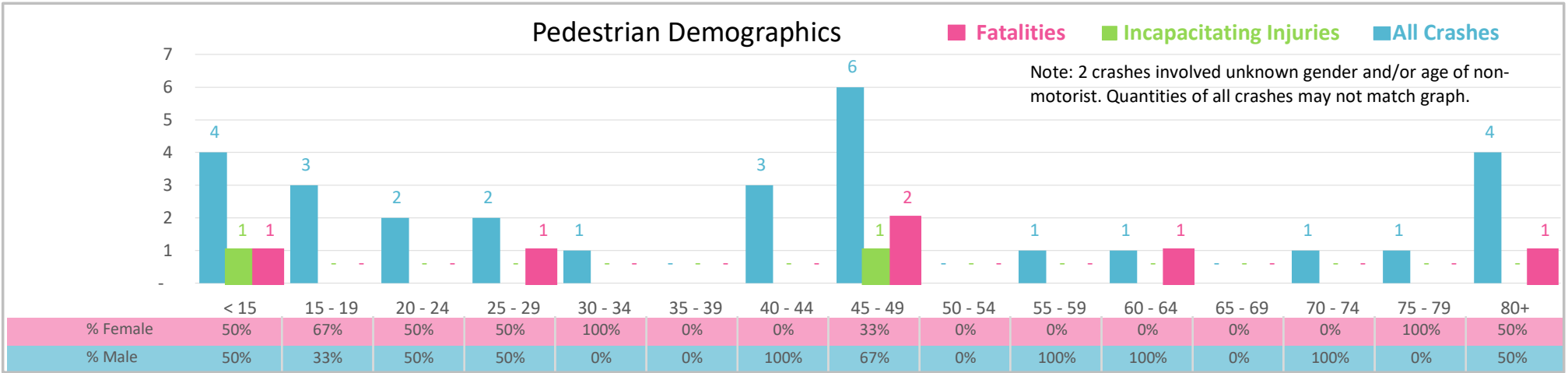

- ### Key Pedestrian Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 74,167.
 - Pedestrian age is distributed broadly across all age groups; male pedestrians account for 70% of all crashes and 4 of 6 fatalities.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 1 crash.
 - Intoxication was not noted as a factor in any of the crashes.
 - 48% of crashes occurred along City Streets with most of the remainder occurring on Other roadway systems.
 - Sport Utility Vehicle and Passenger car both accounted for 32% of the motor vehicles involved in pedestrian crashes.
 - 48% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 4 fatalities.
