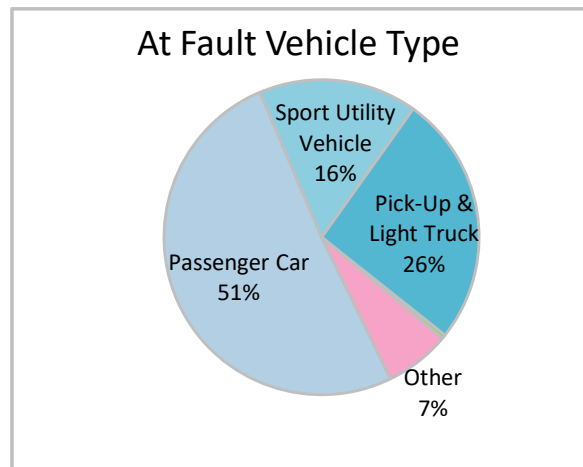
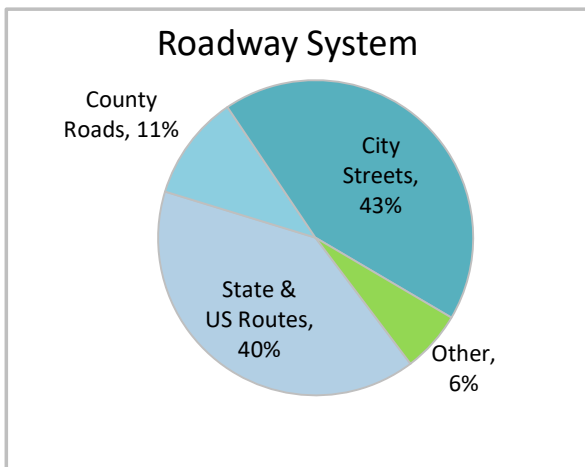
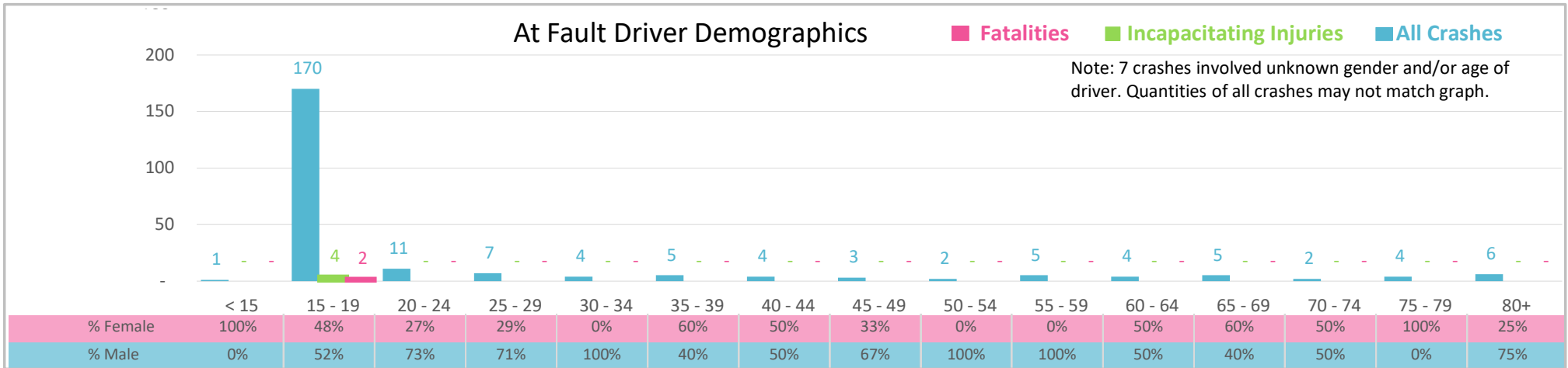

- ### Key Teen Driver Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 74,167.
 - 71% of crashes involved drivers under 20; male drivers account for 55% of all crashes and the 2 fatalities.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 10% of crashes and resulted in the 2 fatalities.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 4% of crashes.
 - 43% of crashes occurred along City Streets with most of the remainder occurring on State and US Routes.
 - Passenger car accounted for 51% of motor vehicles involved in teen driver crashes.
 - 34% of crashes occurred at night.
