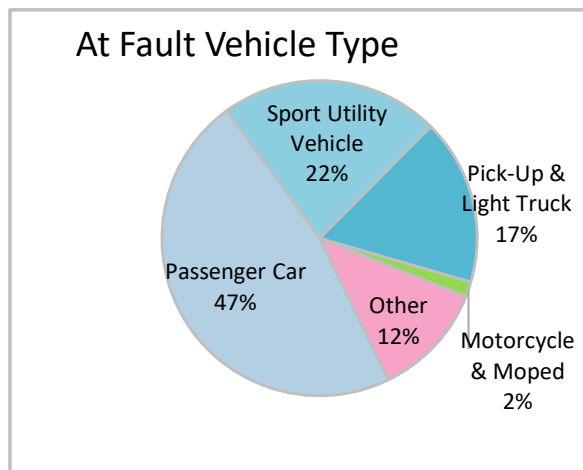
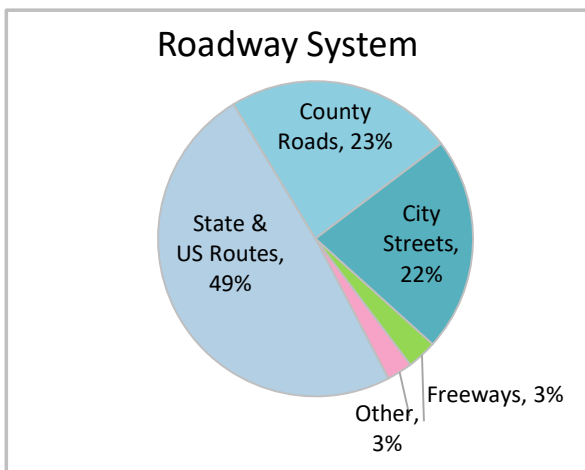
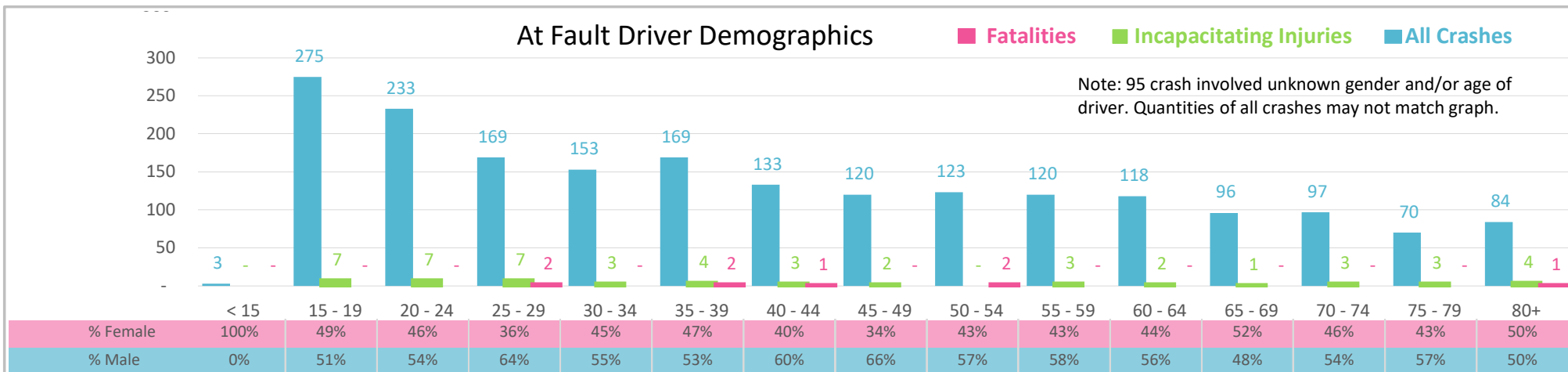

- ### Key Intersection Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 292,466.
  - 49% of crashes involved drivers under 40; male drivers account for 56% of all crashes and 4 fatalities.
  - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 3% of crashes.
  - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 4% of crashes and resulted in 2 fatalities.
  - 49% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on County Roads.
  - Passenger car accounted for 47% of motor vehicles involved in intersection crashes.
  - 21% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 4 fatalities.
