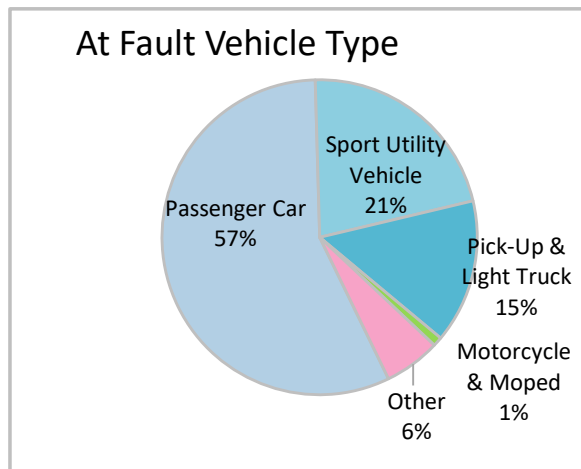
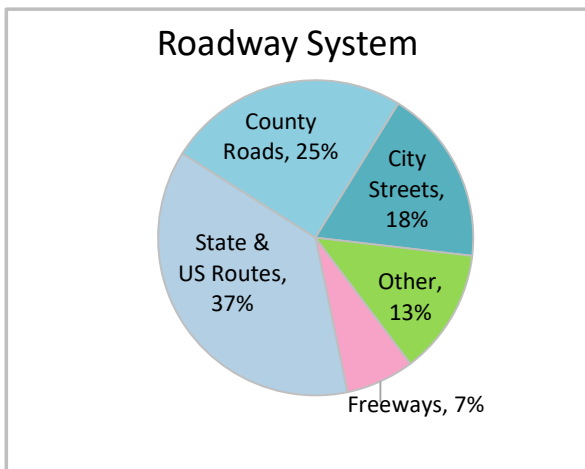
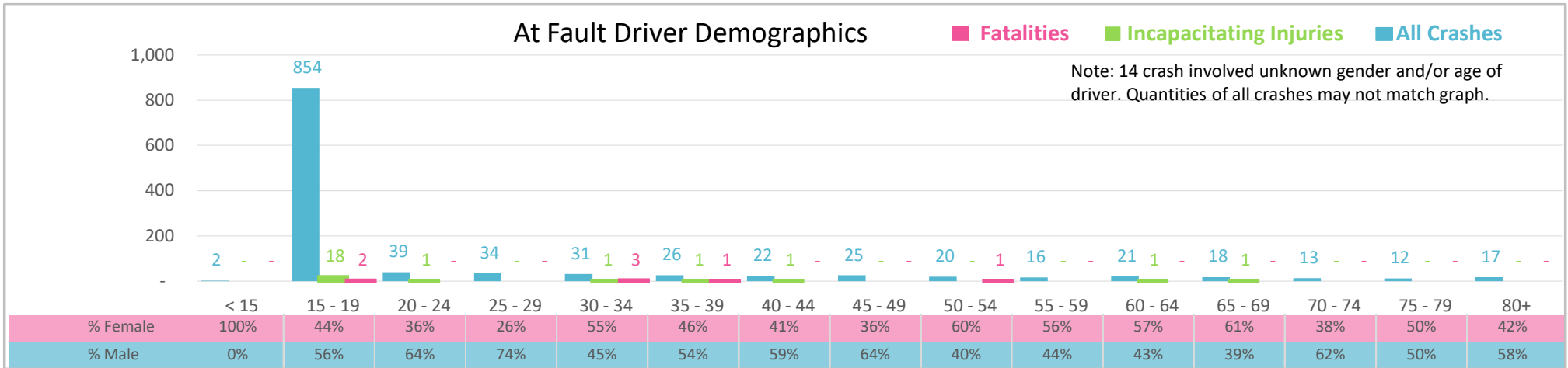

- ### Key Teen Driver Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 292,466.
 - 74% of crashes involved drivers under 20; male drivers account for 56% of all crashes and 5 fatalities.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 3% of crashes resulting in 4 fatalities.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 2% of crashes and resulted in 1 fatality.
 - 37% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on County Roads.
 - Passenger car accounted for 57% of motor vehicles involved in teen driver crashes.
 - 23% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 2 fatalities.
