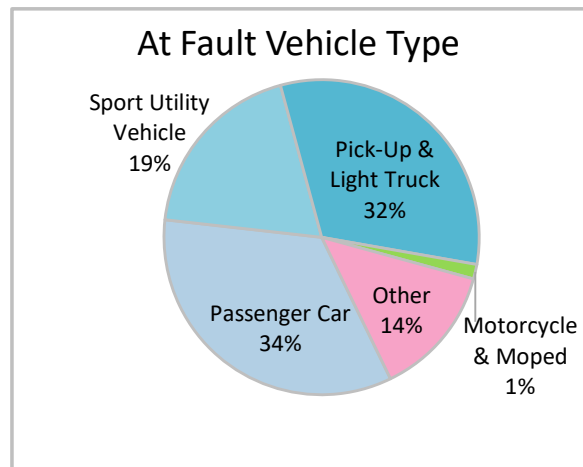
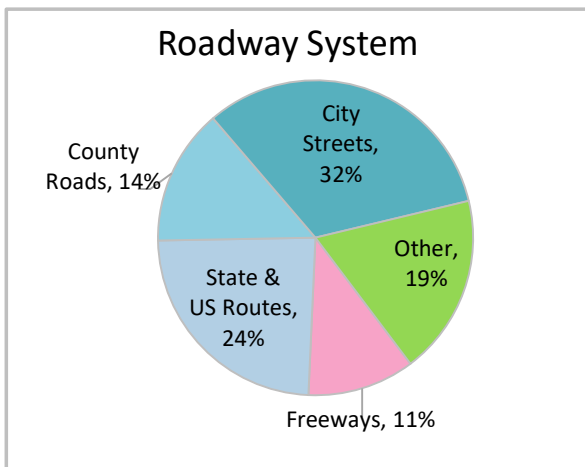
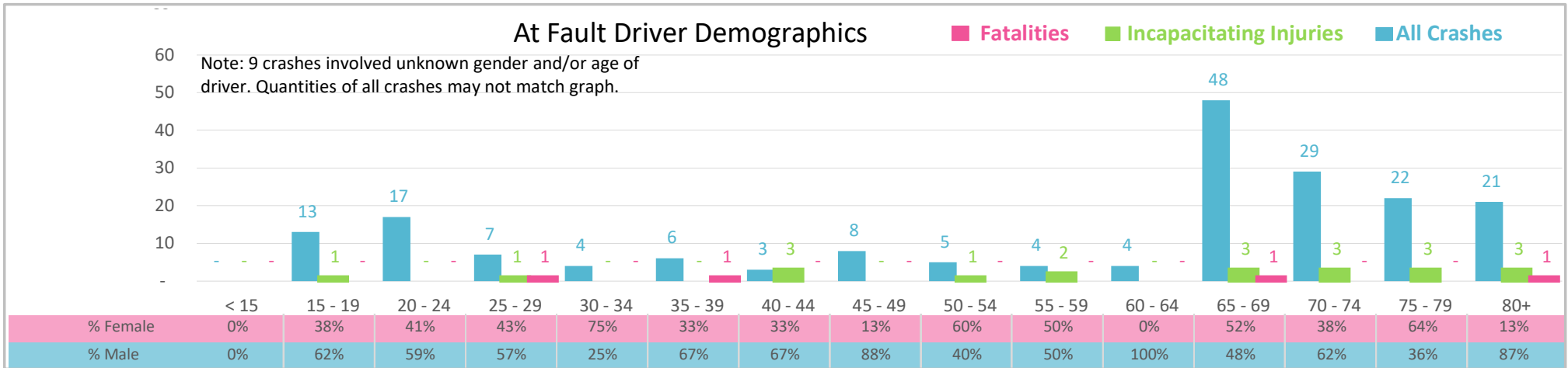

- ### Key Aging Road User Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 44,485.
 - 60% of crashes involved drivers 65 and older; male drivers account for 58% of all crashes and 3 of 4 fatalities.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 5 crashes and resulted in 2 fatalities.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 2 crashes and resulted in the 1 fatality.
 - 32% of crashes occurred along City Streets with most of the remainder occurring on State and US Routes.
 - Passenger car accounted for 34% of motor vehicles involved in aging driver crashes.
 - 21% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 1 fatality.
