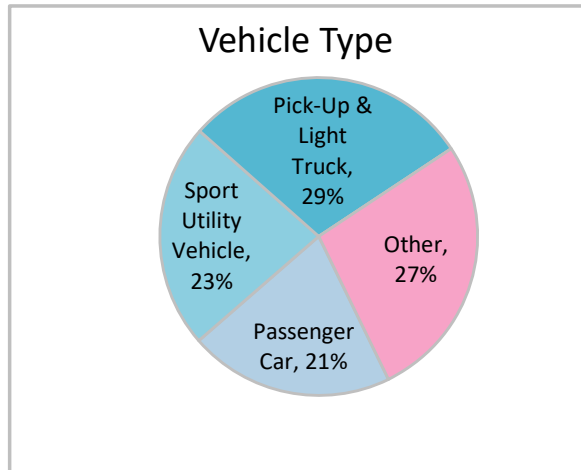
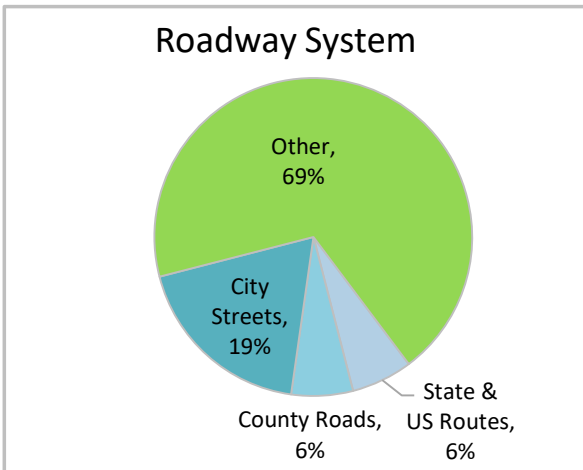
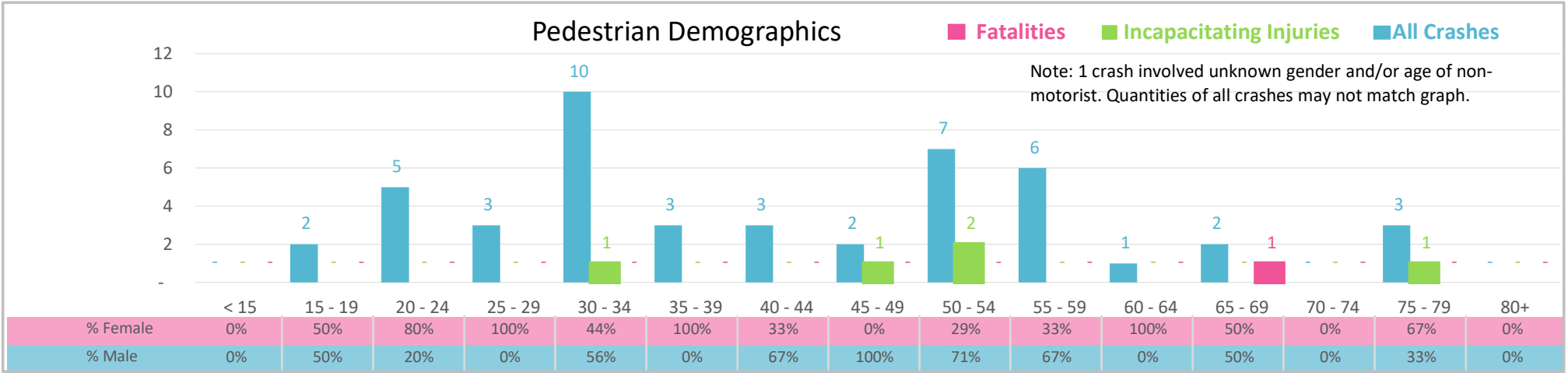

- ### Key Pedestrian Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 44,485.
 - Pedestrian age is distributed broadly across all age groups; male pedestrians account for 55% of all crashes and the 1 fatality.
 - Unrestrained occupant was not noted as a factor in any of the crashes.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 2 crashes and resulted in the 1 fatality.
 - 69% of crashes occurred along Other Roadway Systems with most of the remainder occurring on City Streets.
 - Pick-Up and Light Truck accounted for 29% of the motor vehicles involved in pedestrian crashes.
 - 40% of crashes occurred at night resulting in the 1 fatality.
