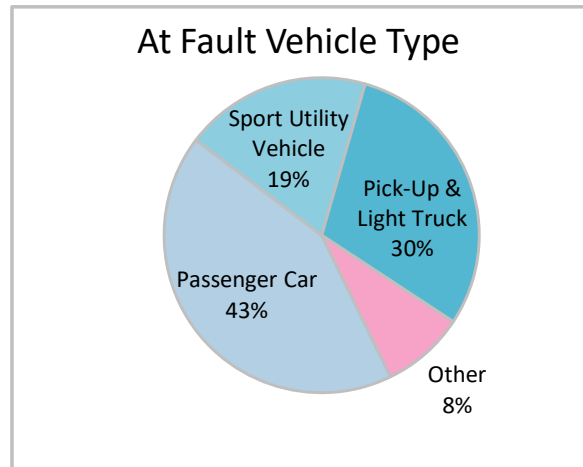
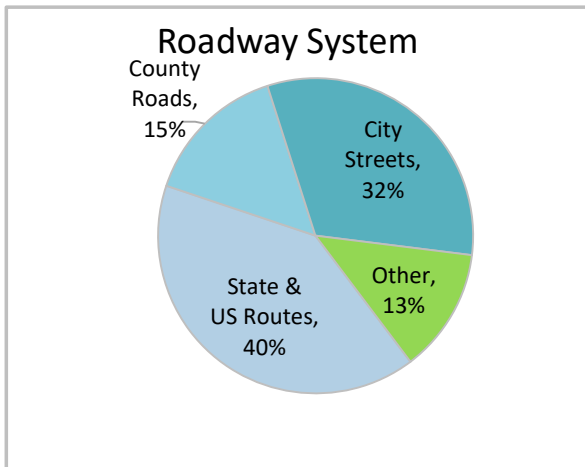
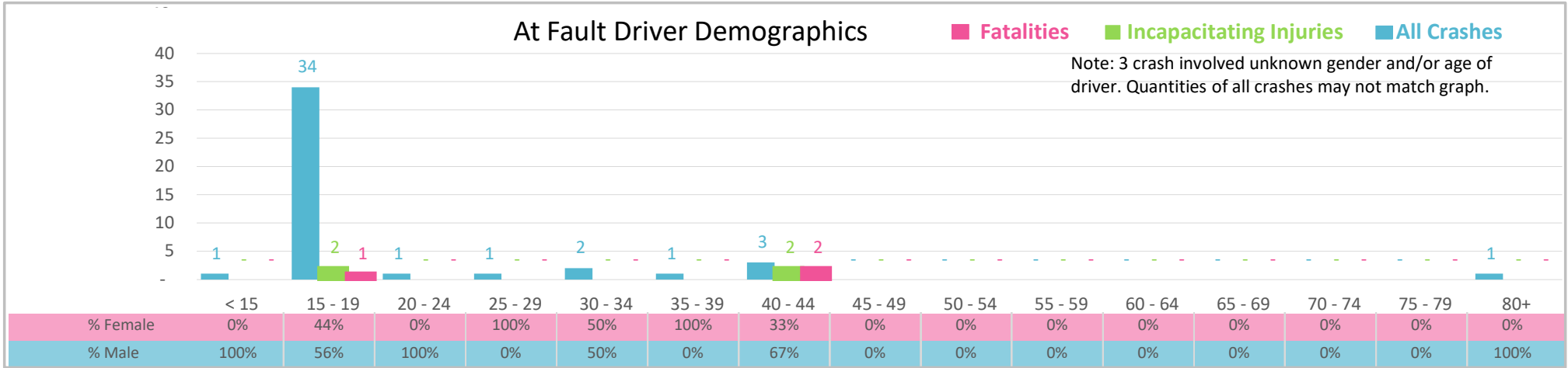

- ### Key Teen Driver Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 21,815.
  - 74% of crashes involved drivers under 20; male drivers account for 57% of all crashes and resulted in the 3 fatalities.
  - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 26% of crashes and resulted in the 3 fatalities.
  - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 3 crashes and resulted in 2 fatalities.
  - 40% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on City Streets.
  - Passenger car accounted for 43% of motor vehicles involved in teen driver crashes.
  - 34% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 2 fatalities.
