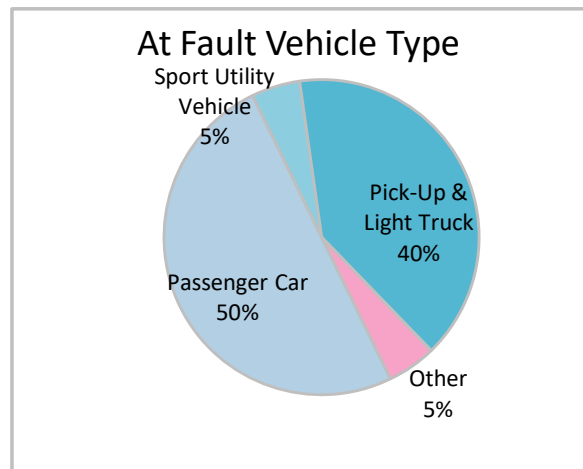
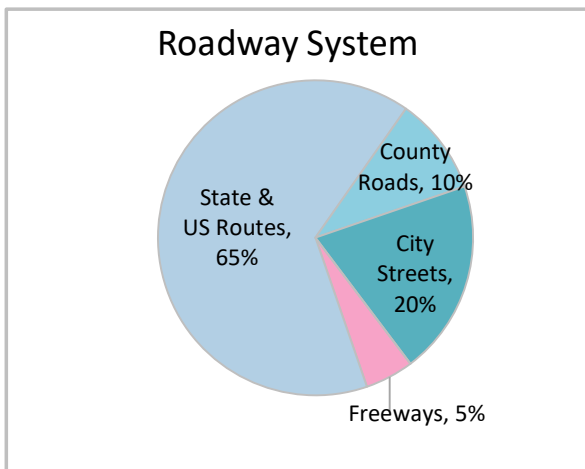
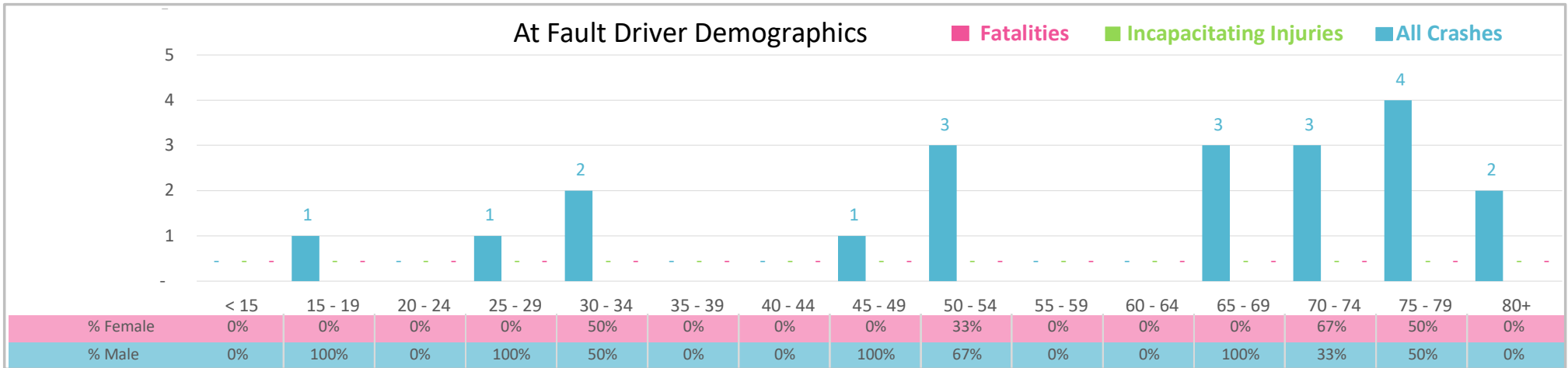

- ### Key Aging Road User Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 16,335.
  - 60% of crashes involved drivers 65 and older; male drivers account for 70% of all crashes.
  - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 4 crashes.
  - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 1 crashes.
  - 65% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on City Streets.
  - Passenger car accounted for 50% of motor vehicles involved in aging driver crashes.
  - 35% of crashes occurred at night.
