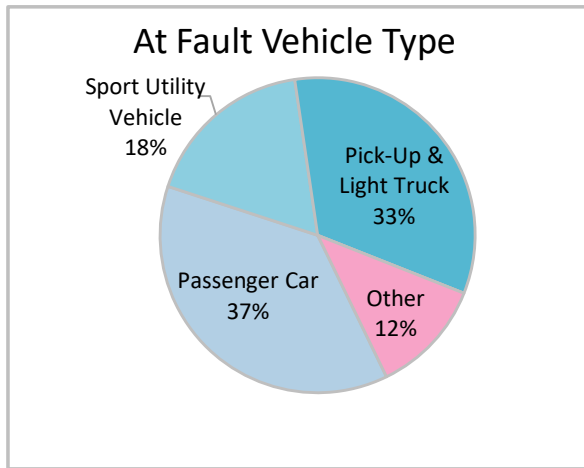
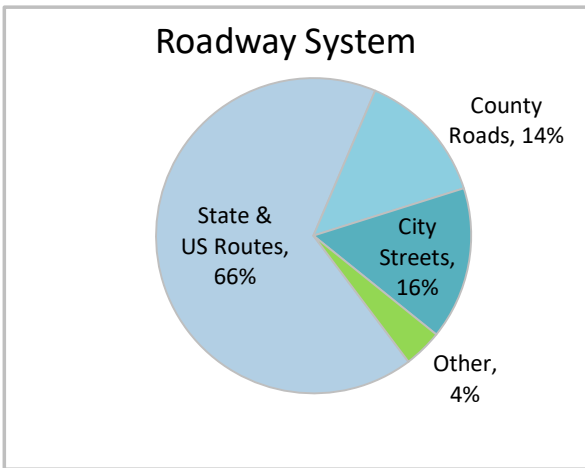
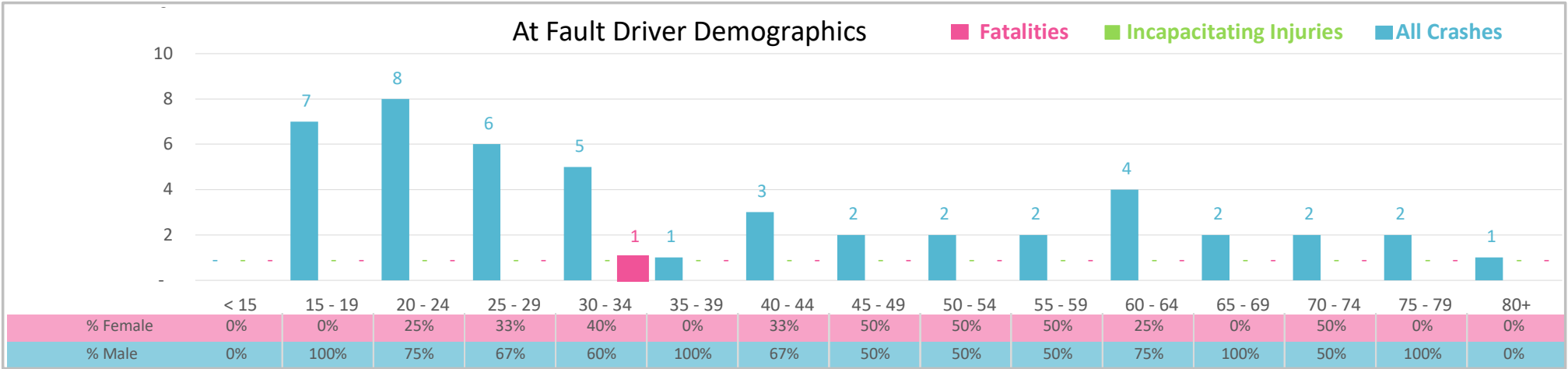

- ### Key Intersection Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 16,335.
 - 51% of crashes involved drivers under 35; male drivers account for 74% of all crashes and the 1 fatality.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 3 crashes and resulted in the 1 fatality.
 - Intoxication was not noted as a factor in any of the crashes.
 - 66% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on City Streets.
 - Passenger car accounted for 37% of motor vehicles involved in intersection crashes.
 - 39% of crashes occurred at night resulting in the 1 fatality.
