Issue Description

Parking lines were painted by FDOT over the entry to this 4 unit condo residential building in January 2026. A complaint was filed on January 10, 2026 to explain that people were parking in front of our driveways due to the incorrectly painted pavement markings. On March 7, 2026 the incorrectly painted lines were removed in front of one side of the building (the left side which allows access to units with addresses of 1534 and 1536 Riverside Ave). As of July 2, 2026, the incorrectly painted lines are still in front of driveway on the other side of the building which results in cars parking across our residential driveway. See pictures attached. This is affecting the driveway for 1530 and 1532 Riverside Avenue.

Issue Description

Overall, traffic in Jacksonville, Duval County, FL, is hampered by the Long wait times at lights. Lights are seldom sequenced to facilitate traffic moving at optimal speeds, with minimal time waiting for the lights to change. Issue Description

Exit 60 - US-1 ramp is one lane from 295. Diverges into 4 lanes beginning approximately 10 car lengths from the intersection. During peak times, the vehicles back up onto 295 while waiting for the signal to change to allow movement. One signal cycle is not always enough to clear the traffic on the ramp. Has this area increased in volume enough to consider widening the offramp sooner?
Drivers often will make this two lanes to try to get to the signal sooner.

Issue Description

Vehicles traveling northbound and southbound on Roosevelt Blvd. continue to fail to yield when turning left onto St. Johns Ave. We often have failure-to-yield crashes there. I personally witnessed a truck that misjudged the speed of oncoming traffic on Roosevelt Blvd. The driver had to rapidly accelerate to avoid being hit. A dedicated-only turn-on green arrow should help reduce crashes and close calls.

Based upon my investigation, no changes to the signal operations should be considered for the intersection. There are specific criteria and guidance set forth in the FDOT Traffic Engineering Manual and District 2 Left Turn Phasing Guidance on when to change a signal from protected/permissive to protected only, and the intersection of St. Johns Ave and US 17 does not meet or exceed these criteria.
07/07/2026 - Sent additional comments from the meeting to Jeff Scott.
07/13/2026 - Response from Jeff Scott - We disagree that FDOT's TEM requires protected-only left turn phasing at this intersection. We have since confirmed that the sight distance to approaching vehicles meeting applicable sight distance requirements. Note that we do not consider the potential presence of an opposing

left turning vehicle to be a sight distance obstruction.

We separately evaluated protected-only left turn phasing by time of day and do not think that is appropriate at this location.

Issue Description

From the on-ramp at Town Center Parkway to southbound SR 9A (I-295), vehicles are crossing all southbound lanes from the on-ramp before the designated merge area ends in order to enter the first E-Pass lane. This behavior creates a significant safety hazard.

It is recommended that the E-Pass lane dividers be extended further north of their current starting point to discourage this unsafe maneuver and improve traffic safety.

05/19/2026 - Email from Lt. Eads - After having our troopers monitor the area and speaking with the troopers who live in the area, this does seem to be a legitimate concern.

We have been conducting enforcement in the area to try and curb the drivers from performing the dangerous driving behavior however this is only a short-term solution I believe.

The times this becomes the biggest safety concern is during rush hour and unfortunately at those peak times the troopers are all responding to calls for service and aren't able to do pro-active enforcement in the area.

I believe the best conclusion would be to have the lane dividers extended further north of their current starting point.

We will continue to monitor and conduct enforcement in the area when possible.

Resolution

05/31/2026 - Approved AR Results -
Conclusions/Recommendations:

- Crash data was reviewed from 4/1/2025 through 4/27/2026. There were no crashes that appear to have been due to vehicles weaving into the managed lanes.
- Two field reviews did not reveal any drivers weaving from the ramp to the managed lane.
- Drivers entering I-295 from Town Center Parkway must cross a double white line and change four lanes to enter the managed lanes.
- There are no recommended changes due to no crashes being found related to the identified concern.

06/17/2026 - Comments from the meeting - Can the cameras record this area to see the driver behaviors? What were the original plans?

06/18/2026 - Andrea spoke to Pete Vega - recording is not a possibility.

07/07/2026 - Sent email to Jeff Scott with comments from the meeting. Asked if delineators can be extended beyond Town Center.

07/09/2026 - Final response from Jeff Scott - An assessment of operations was done. Two field reviews were done when reviewing this request, as stated in the report.

In the absence of any data to support there being a problem necessitating installation of delineators, we do not recommend installing delineators.

Driving Tips for Teens - Traffic Safety Team

100 Deadliest Days for Teen Drivers

The "100 Deadliest Days" is the period between Memorial Day and Labor Day when fatal teen crashes increase dramatically. Nationwide over 7,000 people died in teen-related crashes from 2010–2019 during this summer period.

Teens drivers have a higher rate of fatal crashes, due to immaturity, lack of skills, and lack of experience. Teenagers speed, they make mistakes, they wear their safety belts less often, and they get distracted easily – especially if their friends are in the car.

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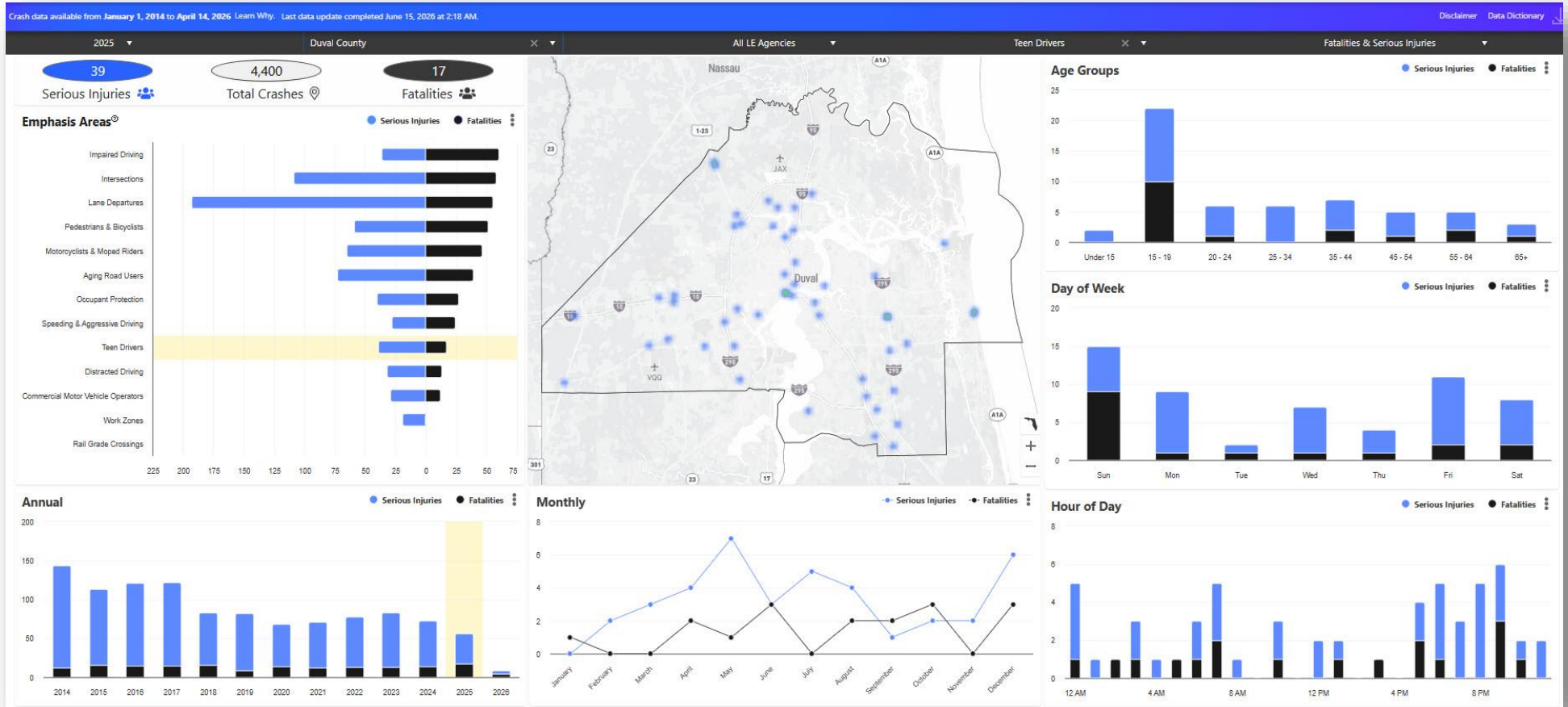
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Duval Crash Data – Teen Driving
